Today's game marks the 95th meeting between Gettysburg and Franklin & Marshall in a series that began with a 68-0 Franklin & Marshall win in 1890. The game was played on Thanksgiving Day for the better portion of the early part of the 20th century. The Diplomats hold a tenuous lead on the series with a 44-43-7 edge.

The bulk of the series has been played out in Lancaster, with 68 of the 94 games on the books having been settled here on the Sponaugle-Williamson gridiron. F&M holds a 36-27-5 lead in those games, and has taken the past two meetings at home. The most recent tie came in 1985, when the squads finished the day without changing the scoreboard. It was the third scoreless tie in the series. Neither team mustered a point in the 1920 or 1921 clashes. All told, there have been 30 shutouts in the series (33 if you count the scoreless ties twice). Gettysburg was the victor in 16 of the shutouts, while F&M has won 11 without surrendering a point. The series has also seen an anomalous 4-4 tie coming in the 1893 meeting.

#### john troxell

fourth season alma mater: lafayette '94 record at f&m: 18-21 (16-15 CC) career record: 18-21 (16-15 CC)

Troxell is in his fourth season as the head coach at Franklin & Marshall College. The Diplomats' mentor has coached 20 All-Centennial Conference players during his first three seasons. Named the 39th coach in F&M football history on March 22, 2006, Troxell took the reins of the Diplomats following five seasons as an assistant coach at Lafayette. His squad won the Patriot League in 2005.





## barry streeter 31st season

alma mater: lebanon valley '71 record at gettysburg: 155-153-5 career record: 155-153-5

Streeter is not only the winningest coach in program history with a record of 152-147-5, but he is also the longest tenured coach having passed the legendary Henry "Hen" Bream (1927-51) on both counts. In addition, Streeter became the all-time winningest coach in Centennial Conference history with a 27-20 win over Moravian College on Oct. 6, 2007, giving him 78 Centennial victories.

#### f&m last week

The Centennial Conference's (CC) top offense and defense collided on Homewood Field Saturday, with the top defense seizing the day. Johns Hopkins' defense held Franklin & Marshall in check, while the Jays' offense rode Andrew Kase to a 51-13 win over the Diplomats. Hopkins' defense took the ball two times, stopped F&M on fourth down four times, and ended three Diplomat drives deep in Hopkins' territory. F&M was limited to 259 yards of offense, 116.5 yards below its season average of 375.5. Meanwhile, Johns Hopkins piled up 507 yards.

### gettysburg last week

Nick DeLuca converted three field goals, including the game-winning 20-yarder as time expired to lift McDaniel to a 22-20 victory over Gettysburg. The Green Terror built

a 13-0 lead over the game's first 22:02 before the Bullets registered 20 of the game's next 26 points to take a one-point lead with four minutes to play. DeLuca, however, capped a 14-play march that covered 54 yards with a 20-yard field goal from the left hash to deliver McDaniel its first win in Gettysburg since 2001.

#### the last meeting

Gettysburg ran to a 54-21 win over Franklin & Marshall on the battlefield. The Bullets piled up 299 yards of rushing on 25 carries in the first half and 434 yards in the game. Three of the first half touches ended in the Diplomats' end zone, giving the Bullets an insurmountable 33-7 lead at the half. Jamel Mutunga and Nick McConnell each rushed for well over 100 yards and two touchdowns.

#### the last meeting in lancaster

Ryan Murray rushed for four of his five touchdowns in the fourth quarter, when Franklin & Marshall outscored Gettysburg 28-7 en route to a 56-38 victory.

Trailing 31-28 heading into the final quarter, F&M went ahead for good on Murray's third touchdown of the game, a one-yard dive with 7:49 left that made it 42-38. Murray rumbled for a school record 240-yards, marking the second time in three games that he had surpassed the 200-yard plateau, and third-straight game he had rushed for 100-or more yards. The victory ended F&M's season with a three-game winning streak.

#### academic accolades

Franklin & Marshall senior offensive lineman, Clarke Miller, was named to the CoSIDA/ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District II Football Second Team when it was released on Thursday.

Miller is a Government major from Richmond, Virginia and a graduate of St. Christopher's School. To be nominated, a student-athlete must be a starter or important reserve with at least a 3.30 cumulative grade point average (on a 4.0 scale) at his/her current institution. The All-District team is voted upon by the district's Sports Information Directors. First team selections move on to Academic All-America balloting.

Miller has started each of F&M's eight games this season at right tackle, giving him 27 career starts. He is the only returning starter on the F&M offensive line in 2009. The senior is the first Diplomat gridder named to the CoSIDA Academic All-District II team since Dan Eggerston landed the honor in 2004, en route to Academic All-American status.

#### the harrison file

Sophomore quarterback, John Harrison, has been rewriting the Franklin & Marshall record book all season. Last week, he became the first Diplomat to complete 200 passes in a season, and just the eighth Diplomat quarterback to throw for 4,000 yards in his career. He can realistically move into sixth place on the career charts today, needing 255 yards to make the jump. Two touchdown passes would tie him for second in career touchdown tosses with Rob Shepardson, the last F&M quarterback that started from the outset of his freshman season. He is 10 touchdowns away from tying the college's career touchdown record. The coveted mark of Joe Coviello stands at 52. ### the waiting was the hardest part

The first Franklin & Marshall quarterback to throw five touchdowns in a game was Wally Witmer in the 1951 meeting with Johns Hopkins, a 52-7 F&M victory. That feat went unmatched for 58 years. **John Harrison** finally matched the effort in the win 42-21 win over Catholic. He ensured that the wait would not be another 58 years, in fact, ensured

that it would not reach 50 days, throwing five touchdowns against McDaniel to tie the school record once again.

#### twice as nice

Barry Lovett's 62-yard interception return for a touchdown marked the second time in as many weeks that he scored a defensive touchdown. He scooped a fumble and scored from 69 yards out against Muhlenberg two weeks back. Lovett's efforts mark the first time a Diplomat defender scored in consecutive weeks since Tim Sheridan did it in 1995. Sheridan returned interceptions of 22 yards and 40 yards in consecutive weeks against Ursinus and Muhlenberg, respectively.

#### touchdowns and tackles

Mike Deutch's two-touchdown day at Mc-Daniel marked the first multiple touchdown game in the junior's career. Just to show that it hadn't gone to his head, he recorded the tackle on the ensuing kickoff after both of his touchdowns.

#### career day

Jarrell Diggs (Baltimore / Gilman) recorded the first 100-yard receiving day of his career at McDaniel. He caught three passes for 127 yards, including F&M's longest reception of the season, a 77-yard catch and run that set up a touchdown.

#### getting it out of the system

Johns Hopkins' 51 points marked the Jays' second week scoring 50 or more points, the first time Hopkins went consecutive weeks with 50 or more since 1967. It is safe to say that the Diplomats ran into a veritable buzz-saw in Baltimore.

Hanging 50 points on Franklin & Marshall is no easy feat. With 1,076 games on the books, only 16 – or 1.49 percent - have seen the opposition score 50 or more points. The bulk of those 50-plus point games came in the first 50 years of F&M football, beginning at Navy on October 19, 1895, a 68-0 loss. F&M is 5-11 in games after the opposition has hung 50. The first bounceback win game against Gettysburg in 1898, a 26-0 win after a 58-0 loss at Princeton. The others came at the expense of Susquehanna, Ursinus, Richmond and Washington & Lee.
