Series History

Despite the fact that only 100 miles separate the institutions, today's ECAC South Atlantic Bowl marks the first time Franklin & Marshall and Wilkes will meet on the gridiron.

Diplomats in ECAC

Today's game marks the seventh ECAC appearance for Franklin & Marshall as well as the fourth ECAC Bowl game hosted by F&M. The Diplomats are 3-3 in ECAC play, and 2-2 in home ECAC games. The first ECAC game against Wagner in 1986 was F&M's first postseason game of any sort. Here is a game-by-game look at F&M in the ECAC:

ECAC Bowl MVP's

To the victor goes the spoils, and for F&M's ECAC victories, the spoils have been ECAC Bowl MVPs. The award has gone to an offensive player in each of F&M's wins. Dale Amos earned the honor at wide receiver in 1987 and 1989. Details are sketchy in the '87 contest, but in the '89 contest, he caught seven Geno Pagnozzi passes for 250 yards and three touchdowns, including a 71-yard streak to the end zone. Running back Scott Stephen earned it in 2004. Stephen rushed for 125 yards and caught three passes for 72 yards to take home the hardware.

ECAC Postseason Awards

Franklin & Marshall College has produced two ECAC Players of the Year at quarterback. Bob Olender was named the 1971 ECAC Player of the Year. Quarterback, Beau Eckert, was the 1996 ECAC Offensive Player of the Year.

ECAC This Season Awards

Two Diplomats were named ECAC Players of the Week during the 2009 campaign. John Harrison earned the Offensive Player of the Week honor following a 404-yard, five-touchdown effort at McDaniel. Barry Lovett earned the Defensive Player of the Week in the same game after scoring a defensive touchdown for the second consecutive game. The senior returned an interception 62 yards for a touchdown, broke up another pass, and registered three tackles.

F&M's Path to the ECAC

The Diplomats rolled up an 8-2 record behind the gunslinging of sophomore signal-caller, John Harrison, who set numerous school and Centennial Conference marks over the course of the 2009 season. F&M's only losses came to Johns Hopkins and Dickinson. The Diplomats posted a 20-7 win over Muhlenberg – the only common opponent - during the torrential downpour that was Homecoming.

Wilkes' Path to the ECAC

The Colonels opened the season with a 14-12 win over Muhlenberg en route to a 3-0 start. Wilkes ran into a buzzsaw, dropping three-straight to Albright, Lebanon Valley and Delaware Valley. The Colonels squeaked out wins in the next three, with a one-point win against FDU-Florham, a four-point win at Lycoming, and a five-point win against Widener.

Troxell is in his fourth season as the head coach at Franklin & Marshall College. The Diplomats' mentor has coached 29 All-Centennial Conference players during his first four seasons. The 39th coach in F&M football history was named the Centennial Conference Coach of the Year at the end of the 2009 regular season.

During his tenure Sheptock has guided the Colonels to eight post-season playoff berths. Over the past seven seasons, Sheptock has led Wilkes to a 47-27 record, highlighted by an 11-1 record in 2006. That year, he was named the MAC and AFCA Region 2 Coach of the Year after leading Wilkes to a conference title and a berth in the NCAA Division III Championship.



F&M Last Week

Franklin & Marshall absorbed two Bullets' touchdowns in rapid succession and then held Gettysburg's offense without a point for almost 48 minutes. While the defense held the Bullets' (3-7, 3-5 CC) potent offense in check, the Diplomats (8-2, 6-2 CC) spread the ball judiciously to rally for a 33-23 Centennial Conference (CC) win.

Wilkes Last Week

The Wilkes University football team (6-4, 3-4) took a short trip across town to take on the King's College Monarchs (3-7, 2-5) in search of its seventh consecutive Mayor's Cup victory. The first quarter saw plenty of offense, but the Monarchs were able to sustain a successful running game and shutdown the Colonels later in the game, ultimately defeating Wilkes 33-16.

Played Like it was Their Last Game

Frank DiMattia, George Eager, Jeff Kellar, Jeff Liberatore, Barry Lovett, Mike Marcinek, Clarke Miller, and Ryan Murray entered the Gettysburg game not knowing if today would come. They played the game like it was their last.

DiMattia recorded three tackles and an interception and return of 41 yards that set up Mike Shin's field goal that made it a three-possession game... Eager Caught 10 passes for 162 yards and took over the school's career record for All-Purpose yards... Kellar posted six tackles, broke up three passes, and ended a Gettysburg drive in F&M territory with an interception... Liberatore recorded six tackles and broke up three passes... Marcinek was in on several of F&M's ten-straight stops of the Bullets' high-octane offense... Miller cleared

the way for John Kaschak's ground success as the sophomore RB became F&M's first 100-yard rusher of the season... Murray rushed four times for 26 yards and caught three passes for 30 yards, including an 18-yard touchdown reception...

Gates, Gonzales, Deutch

Junior Tight End, Mike Deutch, has nine career touchdown catches, ranking him third on the Centennial Conference's list of career touchdowns for the position. He is one TD reception away from matching his predecessor, Matt Mondenendo and two away from tying Muhlenberg's Henry Large, who came up big with 11 touchdowns between 1987 and 1989 for the TE TD record.

F&M Faster Than a Speeding Bullet

All three of Gettysburg's touchdowns came on drives that lasted less than a minute. After scoring on consecutive possession to open the game, the Diplomats' defense held on the next 10 Bull-et possessions.

Like a Broken Record with All of these Records

During the win over Gettysburg, John Harrison reset the Centennial record for completions in a season, passing Western Maryland's Brian Van Deusen who completed 224 passes in 1995. He also passed Ursinus' Frank Vecchio for passing yards in a season. Vecchio threw for 2,709 yards in 1999. He entered the game with 28 touchdowns, having already captured the single season record in that category, previously held by Muhlenberg's Michael McCabe. Harrison's current completion percentage is .4 below that of Western Maryland's Ron Sermarini, who clicked on 68.6 percent of his tosses en route to the 1999 CC championship.

There are several single season milestones Harrison could realistically pass today. He is three completions away from being the first F&M and CC QB to 250 completions in a season, one touchdown pass away from becoming the first F&M and CC QB to throw 30 touchdowns in a season, and 135 yards away from becoming the first F&M and CC QB to throw for 3,000 yards in a season.

There are also several career milestones within reach. Harrison is within 41 yards of sixth place on the F&M career passing yards chart. He is one touchdown away from matching Rob Shepardson in career TDs at 44, good enough for second on the list. He needs 14 completions to move ahead of Kyle Turner for fourth on the career list, 20 completions away from becoming the third Diplomat to 400 completions in his career, and 22 away from overtaking Shepardson's spot in second on the career completion chart. His tenth pass today will be the 600th of his career, which will move him from eighth to sixth on the career chart in that category. We'll be here well past dark before he gets to fifth.

Yeah, He's That Good

John Harrison has been so good this year, he breaks records when he isn't playing. Harrison has thrown five touchdown passes on two occasions this season. Theoretically, that tied him with Wally Witmer, who threw for five touchdowns at Johns Hopkins in 1951 – except for the fact that he didn't. Witmer was responsible for five touchdowns at Hopkins in 1951, three rushing and two receiving, however, going back in media guides at least as far as 1992, he had been credited with five touchdowns. Harrison now owns the record alone, twice.

More About Five TDs

After maintaining sole ownership of the record of Touchdowns Responsible For for 56 years, Wally Witmer was forced to share with Ryan Murray, who rushed for five against Gettysburg in 2007. The club expanded its membership to three with Harrison's pair of five TD performances. With Murray playing in his final game, it is likely that this will be the last time two Fummers responsible for five touchdowns in one game share the field for quite some time.

Purposeful

George Eager moved to the top of the chart for career all-purpose yards during F&M's 33-23 win over Gettysburg. The Diplomats' senior did his work to move up that chart in just three years since transferring up Route 999 from Millersville. He enters today's game with 3,986 all-purpose yards having passed Dale Amos who piled up 3,896 all-purpose between 1986 and 1989.

With his tenth catch last week, Eager joined Amos and Justin Salton as the only Diplomat with 200 career receptions. He needs 54 yards today to join the same pair in the 2,500-career yard club. Amos owns the record at 3,486, followed by Salton at 3,136.

Like Riding a Bike

John Kaschak rushed 25 times for 100-yards, and two touchdowns against Gettysburg, all season highs in F&M's pass-oriented offense. Kaschak was the last Diplomat to rush for 100 yards – back in September of last year. Kaschak pounded out 161 yards on 42 carries against Juniata. He became the first Diplomat to score two rushing touchdowns in one game since Ryan Murray scored five against Gettysburg in the 2007 season finale. In addition to his work on the ground, Kaschak threw a touchdown pass in F&M's 33-23 win over Gettysburg.

Prater's Punting Prowess

Brian Prater was on point most of the day Saturday dropping two punts inside of the Bullets' 15-yardline. Prater dropped one punt on the Gettysburg 12 and boomed his season long of 61 yards before it was downed on the Gettysburg 1.

Kicking Around Being Perfect

Mike Shin was 2-for-2 in PAT attempts and 1-for-1 in field goal attempts in last week's win over Gettysburg. That marks the first time since the 2008 season opener that F&M was perfect kicking for points. In the remnants of a hurricane, Paul Sousa went 3-for-3 on PAT attempts, and 1-for-1 on field goal attempts.

Spread (it around) Offense

Everyone was in on the action in last week's win over the Bullets. Five different players rushed for positive yards. Three different players statistically completed a pass with a fourth completing a two-point conversion pass (which is not recorded as a statistic). Two players completed a touchdown pass. Eight different players caught at least one pass with six catching two or more. Three different players scored touchdowns for F&M.

All-Centennial

Eight members of Franklin & Marshall's football squad earned nine roster spots on the 2009 All-Centennial Conference Football Team. Four players were picked for five spots on the First Team, three players landed on the Second Team, and one was accorded Honorable Mention. The team is selected by the league's head coaches.

Michael Deutch, George Eager, Barry Lovett and Clarke Miller were named to the Centennial's First Team. John Harrison, Sam Massaro and Mark Surma were named to the

Second Team. Jeff Kellar earned Honorable Mention.

The Diplomats' tight end, Deutch is making his first All-Centennial appearance following a regular season in which he caught 32 passes for 356 yards and eight touchdowns. His eight, six-point grabs ties the Conference's single season record for touchdown catches by a tight end that had been owned by a Diplomat, Mike Sernatinger, since 1995.

Eager is making his second consecutive appearance as the first team kick returner and his first appearance on the top team as a wide receiver. He had been relegated to the second team each of the past two seasons. Eager hauled in 79 passes for 1,043 yards and 11 touchdowns. He returned 19 kicks for 434 yards, averaging 22.8 yards per return. He took two to the barn going 80-yards against both Dickinson and Moravian. Eager was one of three unanimous first team choices.

Lovett's selection as a first team defensive back marks the second consecutive season he has earned the distinction. The senior broke up five passes and picked off three more. He rolled up 74 yards on his three interception returns, including a 62-yard return for a touchdown at McDaniel. That marked the second week in as many that Lovett had scored. He scooped and scored from 69-yards out in the win over Muhlenberg. Lovett had 33 tackles on the season, including 27 solo stops. His five tackles for losses included one sack. Lovett was the only defensive player unanimously selected to the first team.

Miller entered the season as the offensive line's only returning starter from the 2008 season. He anchored the right side of the line that protected for the quarterback that turned in the most proficient passing season in CC history. Miller was previously named ESPN the Magazine/CoSIDA Academic All-District II.

Harrison established dozens of records at Franklin & Marshall and in the Centennial Conference this season. His 247 completions, 2,865 yards, and 29 passing touchdowns are all school and Centennial Conference single season records. He turned in Franklin & Marshall's first-ever 400-yard passing effort with 404 yards and five touchdowns - also a school single game record - at McDaniel. Harrison threw for five touchdowns on two occasions this season.

A freshman, Massaro started at middle line-backer from the outset earning Centennial Conference Player of the Week honors after the season-opener. Despite missing the final game of the season to injury, Massaro led F&M in tackles with 22 more than the next closest player. His 70 stops included 43 unassisted efforts, eight for losses, four of which were sacks. Massaro tied for the team lead in interceptions with Lovett, Kellar and Ty Savastio. Each had three on the season.

The team's only junior serving as a captain, Surma is making his first All-Centennial appearance. He recorded 31 tackles, including 16 solo stops this season to go with four sacks and a forced fumble.

A second team pick a year ago, Kellar earned honorable mention this year. He recorded three interceptions and a team-high seven pass breakups in 2009 to go along with 36 tackles. Kellar posted 23 solo stops and three tackles for losses.

Class Act, Too

George Eager was selected as a member of the All-Centennial Conference Sportsmanship Team.

Academic Accolades

Franklin & Marshall senior offensive lineman, Clarke Miller, was named to the CoSIDA/ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District II Football Second Team when it was released on Thursday.

Miller is a Government major from Richmond, Virginia and a graduate of St. Christopher's School. To be nominated, a student-athlete must be a starter or important reserve with at least a 3.30 cumulative grade point average (on a 4.0 scale) at his/her current institution. The All-District team is voted upon by the district's Sports Information Directors. First team selections move on to Academic All-America balloting.

Miller has started each of F&M's eight games this season at right tackle, giving him 27 career starts. He is the only returning starter on the F&M offensive line in 2009. The senior is the first Diplomat gridder named to the CoSIDA Academic All-District II team since Dan Eggerston landed the honor in 2004, en route to Academic All-American status.

John Troxell, Coach of the Year

Franklin & Marshall's head football coach, John Troxell, traded four losses from last season for four wins this season. Leading an extraordinarily young group of Diplomats to an 8-2 record brought F&M's mentor a post-season bid on Sunday. On Monday, it brought him Centennial Conference Coach of the Year honors.

The league's head coaches vote for the Centennial Conference Coach of the Year Award.

"It is a tremendous honor to be recognized by your peers particularly in a conference with so many accomplished coaches," said Troxell. "The honor is a testament to the players who are asked to execute on the field and my staff that works tirelessly to get the players ready. I am grateful for their hard work."

Troxell turned last year's 4-6 record into an 8-2 season with one of the youngest and least voluminous rosters in the Centennial. This season has been a breakthrough for the fourth-year coach. The Diplomats went 3-7 in Troxell's first campaign and 4-6 in each of his past two seasons. F&M's 2009 record included a perfect mark outside of the Centennial Conference, and a 6-2 mark within the league. One of the two losses came on a field goal as time expired.

John Troxell, Coach of the Year, Part II

Troxell is currently third in the Liberty Mutual Coach of the Year voting for Division III. The Liberty Mutual Coach of the Year earns \$50,000 for charity and \$20,000 for his school's general fund. Should Troxell be selected, his charitable contribution will be to The Lauren's First and Goal Foundation.

Twice as Nice

Barry Lovett's 62-yard interception return for a touchdown marked the second time in as many weeks that he scored a defensive touchdown. He scooped a fumble and scored from 69 yards out against Muhlenberg two weeks back. Lovett's efforts mark the first time a Diplomat defender scored in consecutive weeks since Tim Sheridan did it in 1995. Sheridan returned interceptions of 22 yards and 40 yards in consecutive weeks against Ursinus and Muhlenberg, respectively.

touchdowns and tackles

Mike Deutch's two-touchdown day at McDaniel marked the first multiple touchdown game in the junior's career. Just to show that it hadn't gone to his head, he recorded the tackle on the ensuing kickoff after both of his touchdowns.

Career Day

Jarrell Diggs recorded the first 100-yard receiving day of his career at McDaniel. He caught three passes for 127 yards, including F&M's longest reception of the season, a 77-yard catch and run that set up a touchdown.
