Today's Game: Franklin & Marshall (6-4) at Washington & Jefferson (8-2) – ECAC Southwest Bowl

Series History: Today's game marks the eighth meeting between the F&M Diplomats and the W&J Presidents. The series began on November 16, 1946 with the Presidents securing a 33-7 win. W&J leads the series 5-2 and is 2-1 when the Presidents are the home team. F&M's pair of wins in the series came by the same score, 34-0, in 1950 and 1951. That was part of a three-game streak of shut-outs in the series. W&J issued the first blanking, 13-0, in 1947 before the series took a brief hiatus.

F&M Last Week: Gettysburg came away with points on each of its first 10 possessions en route to a 57-35 win over Franklin & Marshall on Saturday. Working his first career start, the Bullets' Kody Smith passed for 281 yards and three touchdowns on a 19-of-28 afternoon for the victory.

W&J Last Week: Washington & Jefferson stopped Waynesburg on a two-point conversion attempt in overtime and recorded its seventh consecutive victory to end the regular season after outlasting the Yellow Jackets 31-30 in the 38th Annual PAC Backyard Brawl at John F. Wiley Stadium.

The Diplomats ECAC History: Today's game marks the eighth ECAC appearance for Franklin & Marshall and the third ECAC Bowl game on the road. The Diplomats are 4-3 in ECAC play, and 1-1 in ECAC games on the road. The first ECAC game at Wagner in 1986 was F&M's first postseason game of any sort. F&M's Last ECAC Appearance: Down two scores to start the fourth quarter, Franklin & Marshall rallied with three unanswered touchdowns to beat Wilkes 29-24 in the ECAC South Atlantic Bowl at Sponaugle-Williamson Field. John Harrison (29-of-38 passing, 231 yards) hit Ryan Murray at the front left pylon for a two-yard scoring strike, and the go-ahead score, with eight seconds left in the game. The final F&M drive was highlighted by Jarrell Diggs connection with George Eager (10 catches, 126 yards) on a 44-yard pass to the Wilkes 26. The score capped off a 19-point fourth quarter for the Diplomats (9-2) as they trailed 24-10 heading into the final quarter.

Something in Common: The Presidents are competing in an ECAC Bowl Game for the second time in W&J's history. In 2003, W&J topped Wilkes 41-19 in Edwardsville, Pa., in the ECAC Southwest Bowl. The Diplomats knocked off Wilkes 29-24 in last year's South Atlantic Bowl.

ECAC Bowl MVP's: To the victor goes the spoils, and for F&M's ECAC victories, the spoils have been ECAC Bowl MVPs. The award has gone to an offensive player in each of F&M's wins. Dale Amos earned the honor at wide receiver in 1987 and 1989. Details are sketchy in the '87 contest, but in the '89 contest, Amos caught seven Geno Pagnozzi passes for 250 yards and three touchdowns, including a 71-yard streak to the end zone. Running back Scott Stephen earned it in 2004. Stephen rushed for 125 yards and caught three passes for 72 yards to take home the hardware. Last year, another running back took the honor. **John Kaschak (Lake Hopatcong, N.J. / Jefferson Twp.)** finished last year's ECAC game with 22 carries for 137 yards and 54 receiving yards on seven catches. He scored a pair of touchdowns in the win.

ECAC Postseason Awards: Franklin & Marshall College has produced two ECAC Players of the Year at quarterback. Bob Olender was named the 1971 ECAC Player of the Year. Quarterback, Beau Eckert, was the 1996 ECAC Offensive Player of the Year.

Smart Football: Two members of the Franklin & Marshall College football team were named to the ESPN/CoSIDA Academic All-District II College First Team when the squad was announced on November 4th. Running back, **John Kaschak** and defensive lineman, **Mark Surma (Sr. / Philadelphia, Pa. / Central)** earned the honor and will be considered for the ESPN/CoSIDA Academic All-American Team.

All-Centennial: Eight members of Franklin & Marshall's football team were named to the All-Centennial Conference Team when it was announced on Tuesday. Tight end, **Michael Deutch (Sussex, N.J. / Vernon Twp.)** and inside linebacker, **Sam Massaro (Old Tappan, N.J. / Northern Valley Old Tappan)** were both named to the All-Centennial First Team. Offensive lineman, **Nick Gerace (Sewell, N.J. / Washington Twp.)**, quarterback, **John Harrison**, defensive end, **C.T. Marsh (Phoenix, Md. / Loyola-Blakefield)**, wide receiver, **Jay Ridinger (Lititz, Pa. / Manheim Twp.)**, and defensive back, **Kurt Rogers (Sudbury, Mass. / Lincoln-Sudbury)** were named to the All-CC Second Team. Defensive lineman, **Mark Surma (Philadelphia / Central)** was given honorable mention.

Did I catch a Niner in There? C.T. Marsh recorded a half sack at Gettysburg, extending his sack streak to nine-straight games and moving him to an equal number on the year. Only 11 Diplomats have gotten to the quarterback 10 times in a year. Chris Lagos piled up 17 sacks in 1993 for the F&M record. Marsh is up to 15.5 sacks on his career and is tied for 11th on the career sacks list with Mike Freeman '92. A sack today would bump him into the top ten, tying him with Joe Gillespie '00.

More Marsh: Marsh has 19.0 tackles for losses of 90 yards this season. The 19 is tied for the second best season on record in the statistic along with Chris Gallino, who had an equal number in 2002. Jon Bushey recorded 35 tackles for losses in 1995. Marsh's 90 yards are second only to Chris Gallino's 94 yards in 2002. Marsh has 29.5 tackles for losses of 139 yards in his career. The TFLs rank 6th all-time at F&M, while the resulting yards lost by the opposition ranks third.

Sounding Like a Broken Record: **John Harrison** owns career records for completed passes (640), pass attempts (978), passing yards (6,903), passing touchdowns (69), completion percentage (65.4), pass efficiency rating (141.1), and touchdowns responsible for (70). He is the only Diplomat to complete 500 passes in his career, let alone 600. At Muhlenberg, he became F&M's first 6,000-yard passer. He will become F&M's first 7,000-yard passer with 97 yards today.

Harrison on the CC Charts: Harrison holds the Centennial Conference (CC) records for passes completed (640), completion percentage (65.4), and touchdowns thrown (69). He became the conference's career leader in touchdown passes during the regular season finale at Gettysburg. Harrison is 337 yards away from the CC record for career passing yards owned by Brian Van Deusen (Western Maryland) since he hung up his cleats in 1995. Harrison's 211-yard effort against Gettysburg marked the 20th time that Harrison threw for 200-yards in a game. Only Van Deusen had more 200-yard passing days in the league's history having hit the mark 23 times.

Harrison tied Van Deusen for the second most 300-yard days in a career at seven during F&M's homecoming win over McDaniel. Muhlenberg's Michael McCabe (1997-2000) holds that record at eight. Harrison's second career 400-yard day tied him with McCabe for most 400-yard days in Centennial history. In 2009, John Harrison became the first F&M and CC QB to 250 completions in a season. He also became the first F&M and CC QB to throw 30 touchdowns in a season, as well as the first F&M and CC QB to throw for 3,000 yards in a season.

One by Land: Harrison is responsible for 70 touchdowns in his collegiate career, but his one-yard plunge against McDaniel marked his first trip into the end zone of the junior's career.

Catch Streak: Wide receivers **Jarrell Diggs (Jr. / Baltimore / Gilman)** and **Jay Ridinger** each extended their streaks of games with a reception during the win over McDaniel. Diggs has caught at least one football in each of his 31 career games to date. Ridinger is on a streak of 27 consecutive games with a catch.

More on Ridinger: **Ridinger** enters today's game fourth in career receptions at F&M with 184 in his career. He is fifth in career receiving yards at 2,107 and touchdowns at 20. A touchdown reception today would tie him with Bob Kaithern '75 for fourth in career touchdowns. Ridinger's 852 yards entering today's game ranks as the ninth best season at F&M, while his 74 catches this year mark the fourth best season on record.

More on Diggs: **Diggs'** 105 career receptions rates eighth all-time in F&M's football history. He needs nine receptions to tie Dale Schleif '73 for seventh on the list. Schleif was inducted into the F&M Hall of Fame on this year's Homecoming Weekend. Diggs ranks 14th in career receiving yards with 1,318 to date. He could realistically climb as high as 11th on the list with a solid showing today. Kaithern is currently 11th on the list with 1,403 yards. Diggs has 51 receptions this year. He is the 13th Diplomat with 50 or more catches in a single season.

Top Tight Ends: **Michael Deutch** recorded eight catches for 102 yards and three touchdowns at Gettysburg. It was his second 100-yard performance in the past three weeks. Deutch owns the College and Centennial career records for touchdowns by a tight end with 16, a record he extended with three touchdowns at Gettysburg. He is second in receiving yards for a tight end behind Mike Sernatinger '97. Last week he became the second F&M tight end and 20th Diplomat to 1,000 yards receiving. He would need 186 yards to tie Sernatinger at 1,255.

Kaschak Can Catch: **John Kaschak** has also broken into the century club in career receptions. He is ninth in career catches, one grab behind Jarrell Diggs. Kaschak ranks 30th in career receiving yards with 864. He need three grabs today to become the 14th Diplomat to 50 receptions in a single season.

Kaschak Can Run: **Kaschak** is currently fifth in career rushing yards with 1,852 yards. He is 35 yards behind Keith Wert '78 on the career rushing list. He is tied with George Darrah '59 and Joe Coviello '77 for sixth in career rushing touchdowns at 17. One more would tie him with Brad Ramsey '88, Ken Scalet '89 and Andy Surtz '97, for third.

Troxell Box

In 2009, Troxell guided the Diplomats to a 9-2 season that was capped by an ECAC South Atlantic Championship victory. Troxell was named the Centennial Conference's Coach of the Year and was one of five national finalists for the highly coveted Liberty Mutual Coach of the Year Award. The 9-2 season marked the Diplomats best campaign dating back to 1996.

Named the 39th coach in Franklin & Marshall football history on March 22, 2006, Troxell took the reins of the Diplomats following five seasons (2001-2005) as an assistant coach at Lafayette during which he served as video coordinator, running backs coach, recruiting coordinator and special teams coach for the 2004 and 2005 Patriot League champion Leopards.

During his tenure, he mentored 2004 Patriot League Offensive Player of the Year Joe McCourt '05 to a record-setting career. Under Troxell's tutelage, McCourt, the 2001 Patriot League Rookie of the Year, concluded his career as Lafayette's and the Patriot League's all-time leader with 50 rushing touchdowns, and second on the school's all-time rushing list with 4,474 yards while earning All-America honors in 2002 and 2004.

Named the Leopards' recruiting coordinator prior to the 2003 season, Troxell landed 24 freshmen for the 2005 season, including 10 who were all-state players. He joined the Lafayette staff after serving as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Muhlenberg College from 1997-2000.

He served as special teams coordinator (1997-99), quarterbacks and wide receivers coach (1997-2000) and offensive coordinator (2000) at Muhlenberg as the Mules went from a 1-9 season in 1997 to the Eastern College Athletic Conference title with a record of 9-2 in 2000. In 2000, his offense ranked 22nd in Division III and led the Centennial Conference in total offense (427.8 yards per game) while averaging 31.0 points per game.

In his first three seasons at Muhlenberg, Troxell coordinated the Mules' special teams. Under his guidance, Muhlenberg led Division III in kickoff returns. Josh Carter, Lafayette's offensive assistant in 2004, was the Football Gazette specialist of the year under Troxell's tutelage. He also coached the quarterbacks and receivers all four seasons, including Muhlenberg's all-time leading passer and Carter, the program's first Centennial Conference player of the year.

Troxell joined the Muhlenberg staff after serving as an assistant coach for three seasons at Columbia University. He assisted with the Lions' defensive backs from 1994-96, helping them record the third-best pass defense in Division I-AA in 1996. The assistant recruiting coordinator his final two seasons at Columbia, he was elevated to running backs coach in the spring of 1997.

A 1994 Lafayette graduate with a B.A. in government and law, Troxell was the starting free safety on the Leopards' 1992 Patriot League championship team and received the program's Unsung Hero Award as a senior. He went on to earn a M.A. in sociology and education from Columbia in 1997. A native of Phillipsburg, N.J., Troxell and his wife, Pamela, have two daughters: Summer and Capri.
