**Today's Game:** Ursinus (1-0, 0-0 CC) at Franklin & Marshall (1-0, 0-0 CC)

**Series History:** Today's game marks the 92nd renewal of a series that dates back to 1894. The Diplomats have taken six of the last eight meetings and each of the last two. Franklin & Marshall holds a 62-25-4 lead in the series and a 19-8 lead since Centennial play began in 1983. In games played in Lancaster, F&M leads 34-11-2. The Diplomats won the initial contest by a score of 76-0. The Bears picked up their first win over F&M in the sixth meeting, a 16-0 victory in Collegeville in 1902.

**The Last Meeting:** Touchdowns on three consecutive possessions was all Franklin & Marshall needed to hand Ursinus a 21-14 loss, their first setback in Centennial Conference (CC) play during the 2009 season. **John Kaschak (Lake Hoptacong, N.J. / Jefferson Twp.)** did the bulk of the damage with 129 yards and two touchdowns, moving F&M to 4-1 (2-1 cc) for the first time in five years.

**The Last Meeting in Lancaster:** Wide receiver **Jarrell Diggs (Baltimore / Gilman)** was responsible for three touchdowns, fueling Franklin & Marshall's 51-13, 2008 homecoming win over Ursinus. Diggs rushed for a score, then threw and received a touchdown pass in the CC win. The Diplomats moved to 3-2 (2-1 CC), while Ursinus fell to 2-3 (1-2 CC).

**Ursinus Last Week:** Ursinus senior quarterback Justin Decristofaro threw for 248 yards and two touchdowns in addition to running for another as the Bears (1-0) won their 2010 season opener with a 21-13 win over Albright (0-1) on Saturday night at Shirk Stadium. Decristofaro was 21-for-35 on the night. The Bears won their season opener for the third time in the last four seasons.

**F&M Last Week:** Franklin & Marshall quickly built a 17-0 lead and never looked back in a 35-7 win over Washington & Lee in the season opener for both teams. The Generals (0-1) turned the ball over four times. The turnovers included a pair of interceptions in the Diplomats (1-0) end zone, and saw **Shane Gray (State College, Pa. / State College)** scoop a **Sam Massaro (Old Tappan, N.J. / Northern Valley Old Tappan)** induced fumble to score from 25-yards out just 43 seconds after F&M had gone ahead 7-0 on its opening possession.

**575:** Franklin & Marshall's win over Washington & Lee was the program's 575th victory.

**The Coaches:** **John Troxell** is in his fifth year as the Diplomats head coach. With the win over Washington & Lee last week, he broke even on his record at 21-21. His fourth year ended on an upswing. The Diplomats mentor delivered a 9-2 record and an ECAC bowl win. He was named the Centennial Conference's Coach of the Year and was a national finalist for the highly coveted Liberty Mutual Coach of the Year Award, finishing in second place in fan voting. Troxell and his staff were also selected to coach the South Team offense in the D3 All-Star Classic.

**Peter Gallagher** enters his tenth season as football coach and is the 27th head coach in the program's 114-year history. He enters today's game with a record of 41-52. He led the Bears to a 6-5 record in 2009, with a 6-2 mark in conference play. Those six wins were the most in Centennial play for

the Bears since 1999. The 2006 season marked the first time under Gallagher that the Bears made their first postseason appearance, competing in the ECAC Southwest Bowl. The 8-3 squad also tallied a 4-2 Centennial Conference mark, finishing second in the CC.

**Centennial Season Opener:** As far as history is concerned, no team has fared better in its Centennial Conference opener than Franklin & Marshall. The Diplomats are 17-10 in their first Centennial game of the season.

**Pride of Ownership:** The Diplomats held the ball for 23:27 of the first half in the win over Washington & Lee. The lopsided time of possession yielded lopsided statistics. F&M rolled up 312 yards of offense compared to Washington & Lee's four and took a 29-0 lead into the break.

**Player of the Week: John Harrison (Flourtown, Pa. / La Salle College High School),** was named the Centennial Conference's Co-Offensive Player of the Week. The junior completed 24-of-31 passes for 305 yards and three touchdowns during the Diplomats' 35-7 win over Washington & Lee. The Player of the Week honor is the third of Harrison's career, while the 300-plus yard passing effort was the sixth of his career. He was named the Centennial's Offensive Player of the Week twice in 2009. All five of his previous 300-yard performances came in 2009 as well. It was also the 10th game of Harrison's career that he finished with three or more touchdown passes. He needs three more touchdown tosses to match the F&M career mark of 52 owned by Joe Coviello who threw 52 touchdowns between 1973 and 1976.

**A Season of Firsts:** In 2009, Harrison became the first F&M and CC QB to 250 completions in a season. He also became the first F&M and CC QB to throw 30 touchdowns in a season, as well as the first F&M and CC QB to throw for 3,000 yards in a season.

**Record Holder:** Harrison sits alone atop of the charts for career completion percentage at F&M. 65.1 percent of his tosses wind up in the hand of his receivers. His 141.9 pass efficiency rating is also tops in the F&M fraternity of quarterbacks. Harrison (4,758) is 15 yards away from tying Kyle Turner (4,773) at third on the F&M career passing yards list. Harrison (49) is three touchdown tosses from tying Joe Coviello for the F&M career touchdown record at 52.

**Eight is Enough:** Eight different receivers caught passes in the win over W&L. **Tim Muller (Pound Ridge, N.Y. / Fox Lane)** caught his first career pass, a 38-yard touchdown strike from Harrison. **Jay Ridinger (Lititz, Pa. / Manheim Twp.)** moved up to sixth in career receptions and career touchdown receptions at F&M. He now sits on 118 catches, 15 of which were touchdowns. **Michael Deutch (Sussex, N.J. / Vernon)** had only two receptions, but made them count. His 53-yard catch and run on the first series set up Kaschak's game-opening touchdown. His second reception of the day resulted in six points for the Diplomats.

**Pick Wisely:** Two of W&L's drives ended in the F&M end zone with F&M interceptions. **Nick Barbieri (Glen Mills, Pa. / Penncrest)** and **Chris DeStefano (Berwyn, Pa. / Conestoga)** each recorded their first career picks.

**Cracking the D3Football.com Top 25?** Both Franklin & Marshall College and Ursinus College received votes in this week's D3Football.com poll. F&M earned seven points in the poll, while Ursinus earned one. The Diplomats have never broken into the D3Football.com Top 25 since its inception in 2003. The D3football.com Top 25 is voted on by a panel of 25 coaches, Sports Information Directors and media members from across the country, and is published weekly.

**Preseason Rankings:** Franklin & Marshall's football team will enter the 2010 season as the 25th ranked team in the nation according to *The Sporting News*. F&M is also receiving votes in the D3Football.com Top 25. The Diplomats are coming off of a 9-2 season, that concluded with a come-from-behind, 29-24 win over Wilkes in the ECAC South Atlantic Championship game.

**Centennial Poll Position:** F&M is ranked second in the Centennial Conference preseason football poll and collected seven of the 20 first place votes. Only reigning Centennial Champions Johns Hopkins finished ahead of F&M in the poll with 11 first place nods.

**Captain's Choice:** Seniors **Jay Ridinger** and **Mark Surma (Philadelphia, Pa. / Central)** will lead the 123rd edition of Diplomats football through the 2010 campaign.

**Individual Preseason Nods:** Tight end, **Michael Deutch**, and defensive lineman, **Mark Surma**, were named preseason All-Americans by D3proday.com. Surma was named to the third team, while Deutch earned honorable mention. The team is limited to seniors.

An All-Centennial Second Team pick in 2009, Surma served as the Diplomats' lone junior captain. He will reprise the role in 2010 following a season in which he posted 33 tackles, including four sacks. He forced a fumble as well.

Deutch was an All-Centennial First Team choice in 2010. He wrapped up the season with 35 receptions for 375 yards. He caught nine touchdown passes in 2009 to help the Diplomats to a 9-2 mark and the ECAC South-Atlantic title.

**All-Conference Returnees:** Four of F&M's eight All-Centennial selections from 2009 return to the gridiron for the 2010 season. Tight end, **Michael Deutch**, is the only returning first team choice, while quarterback **John Harrison**, inside linebacker **Sam Massaro**, and defensive lineman, **Mark Surma** are returning second team choices.

Deutch made his first All-Centennial appearance following a regular season in which he caught 35 passes for 375 yards and nine touchdowns. His nine, six-point grabs set the Conference's single season record for touchdown catches by a tight end. The record had been owned by a Diplomat, Mike Sernatinger, since 1995.

Harrison established dozens of records at Franklin & Marshall and in the Centennial Conference this season. His 276 completions, 3,096 yards, and 32 passing touchdowns are all school and Centennial Conference single season records. He turned in Franklin & Marshall's second-ever 400-yard passing effort with 404 yards and five touchdowns - also a school single game record - at McDaniel. Harrison threw for five touchdowns on two occasions during the 2009 season.

A freshman in 2009, Massaro started at middle linebacker from the outset earning Centennial Conference Player of the Week honors after the season-opener. Despite missing the final game of the season to injury, Massaro led F&M in tackles with 22 more than the next closest player. His 70 stops included 43 unassisted efforts, eight for losses, four of which were sacks. Massaro tied for the team lead in interceptions with Lovett, Kellar and Ty Savastio. Each had three on the season.

Surma made his first All-Centennial appearance. He recorded 33 tackles, including 17 solo stops this season to go with four sacks and a forced fumble.

**ECAC Bowl MVP's:** To the victor goes the spoils, and for F&M's four ECAC victories, the spoils have been ECAC Bowl MVPs. The award has gone to an offensive player in each of F&M's wins, most recently, **John Kaschak**, who finished with 22 carries for 137 yards, his second consecutive game hitting the century mark, and 54 receiving yards on seven catches.

Dale Amos earned the honor at wide receiver in 1987 and 1989. Details are sketchy in the '87 contest, but in the '89 contest, he caught seven Geno Pagnozzi passes for 250 yards and three touchdowns, including a 71-yard streak to the end zone. Running back Scott Stephen earned it in 2004. Stephen rushed for 125 yards and caught three passes for 72 yards to take home the hardware.
