Tonight's Game: Franklin & Marshall (1-1, 0-1 CC) at Dickinson (0-1, 0-0 CC): The Battle for the Conestoga Wagon

Series History: Overall: F&M 59-39-3 | In Centennial: DC 19-8 | In Carlisle: F&M 32-20-3 | Streak: DC +6

The series started in Carlisle on October 30, 1889, with a 10-0 Dickinson win. The teams gathered again on November 28th of that year, with F&M posting a 22-0 shutout. The Diplomats lead the series 59-39-3, but Dickinson has won 19 of the last 22 meetings.

The Wagon: Since 1963, the F&M Diplomats and Dickinson Red Devils have played for a model of the wagon that transported both teams to play each other in the two 1889 meetings. A gift of F&M Athletic Director J. Shober Barr and Dickinson A.D. Dave Eavenson, the trophy is meant to symbolize the friendly gridiron rivalry between the two institutions, F&M holds a 24-21 advantage since the inception of the trophy game, including an 18-year victory winning from 1970 until 1987. Dickinson has held the trophy since 2004.

The Last Meeting: Gordon Craig chipped in a 19-yard field goal as time expired to lead Dickinson to a 45-43 comeback win over Franklin & Marshall at Sponaugle-Williamson Field. The win kept the Conestoga Wagon Trophy in the Red Devil's hands for the sixth straight season. Dickinson remained perfect on the season while the Diplomats suffered their first loss. Craig's kick capped off a 10-play, 60-yard, drive that began at Dickinson's 36-yard line with the Diplomats leading 43-42 with 3:42 left in the game. F&M took 43-42 lead with 3:49 left in the game when Jarell Diggs (5 catches, 49 yards) made a one-handed catch in the end zone while being draped by a Dickinson defender. John Harrison (28-of-42, 347 yards) converted the two-point pass to Ryan Murray.

The Last Meeting in Carlisle: It was the 100th meeting between the teams, Dickinson's first-ever night game at home, and 1,000th contest as a program. Greg Lord rushed for 115 yards and three touchdowns leading Dickinson to a 34-20 win over Franklin & Marshall. The win left the Conestoga Wagon Trophy in Carlisle for the fifth straight year. Lord's final two touchdowns were the difference in the fourth quarter. He plunged in from a yard out early in the period, capping a 72-yard drive to make it 28-20 in favor of the Red Devils. The Diplomats responded with a 58-yard drive that left them deep in Devils territory. On third and goal from the Dickinson two-yardline, **John Harrison (Flourtown, Pa. / LaSalle College HS)** was hurried into a low throw that was picked off by Matt Stone, who immediately fumbled the ball forward. Dickinson recovered the ball on their own 18, and then marched 82 yards on 12 plays to set up Lord's final score, a three-yard jaunt to make it the 34-20 final.

Dickinson Last Week: Hobart recorded a 38-7 win over visiting Dickinson in the season opener for both teams. Special teams played a big role in Hobart's victory, setting up the offense's first touchdown of the day and producing two more scores. First-year running back Steven Webb led all rushers with 58 yards and two touchdowns in his first game as a Statesman. He also returned the opening kickoff of the second half 90 yards for a touchdown. Eleven Hobart rushers combined for 133 yards on the ground.

F&M Last Week: Justin Decristofaro's 22-yard touchdown pass to Nick Giarratano gave Ursinus its first lead with 6:21 left in the game. The Bears (2-0, 1-0 CC) defense held firm the rest of the way, delivering Ursinus a 10-7 win over Franklin & Marshall in the Centennial opener for both squads. Ursinus limited the Diplomats to 235 yards on the day. F&M held the Bears to 291 yards of total offense. The teams combined for eight sacks, four apiece, with F&M's **C.T. Marsh (Phoenix, Md. / Loyola-Blakefield)** accounting for half of the Diplomats' total. Marsh led F&M with 10 tackles on the afternoon, four stops were for losses including his pair of sacks.

Friday Night Lights: Tonight's contest marks the fourth time the Diplomats have played a Friday night game since John Troxell took over the program in 2006. A win tonight would be the Diplomats first night victory under F&M's fifth-year mentor.

The Coaches: **John Troxell** is in his fifth year as the Diplomats head coach. He is 21-22 in his career. His fourth year ended on an upswing. The Diplomats mentor delivered a 9-2 record and an ECAC bowl win. He was named the Centennial Conference's Coach of the Year and was a national finalist for the highly coveted Liberty Mutual Coach of the Year Award, finishing in second place in fan voting. Troxell and his staff were also selected to coach the South Team offense in the D3 All-Star Classic.

Darwin Breaux is in his 18th season at the helm. Breaux has compiled a 110-65-1 record and guided the Red Devils into postseason play five times, leading the team to the 2007 ECAC southeast championship and the NCAA playoffs in 2006. In 2001 he replaced Ed Sweeney with the most overall wins in the history of the program. Sweeney posted 56 wins from 1985-92.

Tough Drive: F&M has only allowed the opposition two drives greater than half the field through two games this season. Washington & Lee owns the longest drive against the Diplomats thus far marching 63 yards for their only touchdown in that game. Ursinus' 59-yard drive that led to a field goal was their longest of the day. Opposing offenses' drives last, on average, five plays and cover 19.92 yards before the ball is returned to F&M's offense.

Bear Hunter: **C.T. Marsh** has two multiple sack games to his credit. Both were against Ursinus. Marsh led all Diplomat tacklers with 10 stops, eight solo, against Ursinus. That effort included four tackles for losses of 23 yards, half of which were sacks for losses of 16 yards. That performance landed him on the Centennial Conference's Weekly Honor Roll. A year ago at Ursinus, Marsh recorded 1.5 sacks resulting in 11 yards of setbacks for the Bears.

Ridinger's Ride Up the Charts: **Jay Ridinger (Lititz, Pa. / Manheim Twp.)** recorded the fourth 100-yard receiving day of his career on Saturday. The senior hauled in six passes for 118 yards, including a 29-yard reception that set up the Diplomats' lone touchdown against the Bears. His last 100-yard receiving game came during last year's last-second loss to Dickinson on Sponaugle-Williamson Field.

Ridinger is one catch away from the 125th of his career. He ranks sixth in F&M history in passes caught. He is 45 yards away from becoming the ninth Diplomat to record 1,500 receiving yards in his career. He is a touchdown away from tying Larry LoVecchio for fifth on the career touchdown receptions list at 16.

Harrison Approaching Milestones: John Harrison is one touchdown pass away from becoming only the second F&M quarterback to throw 50 touchdowns in his career. He is three touchdown passes away from tying Joe Coviello's '77 record of 52 career touchdown tosses. He is four pass attempts away from becoming the sixth Diplomat to throw 700 passes. He is one completion away from the 450th connection of his career and 30 completions away from tying the F&M record of 479 completions owned by Bill Meekings '94. Harrison needs 49 yards to become the fifth F&M passer to 5,000 yards in his career.

Harrison's Records: Harrison's 65.7 career completion percentage and 144.2 passer rating are career records at F&M.

Kaschak's Climb: **John Kaschak** became the ninth Diplomat to reach 1,300 yards in his career during the loss to Ursinus. The junior is 91 yards away from tying Tom Donaldson '77 for eighth on the career rushing charts at F&M. Kaschak also broke into the top ten in rushing attempts. He sits ninth with 330 carries.

No Two Look the Same: Franklin & Marshall has scored six touchdowns this season. Six different players have been responsible for this season's touchdowns.

575: Franklin & Marshall's win over Washington & Lee was the program's 575th victory.

Pride of Ownership: The Diplomats held the ball for 23:27 of the first half in the win over Washington & Lee. The lopsided time of possession yielded lopsided statistics. F&M rolled up 312 yards of offense compared to Washington & Lee's four and took a 29-0 lead into the break.

Player of the Week: **John Harrison**, was named the Centennial Conference's Co-Offensive Player of the Week in week one. The junior completed 24-of-31 passes for 305 yards and three touchdowns during the Diplomats' 35-7 win over Washington & Lee. The Player of the Week honor is the third of Harrison's career, while the 300-plus yard passing effort was the sixth of his career. He was named the Centennial's Offensive Player of the Week twice in 2009. All five of his previous 300-yard performances came in 2009 as well. It was also the 10th game of Harrison's career that he finished with three or more touchdown passes. He needs three more touchdown tosses to match the F&M career mark of 52 owned by Joe Coviello who threw 52 touchdowns between 1973 and 1976.

Eight is Enough: Eight different receivers caught passes in the win over W&L. **Tim Muller (Pound Ridge, N.Y. / Fox Lane)** caught his first career pass, a

38-yard touchdown strike from Harrison. **Jay Ridinger** moved up to sixth in career receptions and career touchdown receptions at F&M. He now sits on 118 catches, 15 of which were touchdowns. Michael Deutch (Sussex, N.J. / Vernon) had only two receptions, but made them count. His 53-yard catch and run on the first series set up Kaschak's game-opening touchdown. His second reception of the day resulted in six points for the Diplomats.

Pick Wisely: Two of W&L's drives ended in the F&M end zone with F&M interceptions. **Nick Barbieri (Glen Mills, Pa. / Penncrest)** and **Chris DeStefano (Berwyn, Pa. / Conestoga)** each recorded their first career picks.

A Season of Firsts: In 2009, Harrison became the first F&M and CC QB to 250 completions in a season. He also became the first F&M and CC QB to throw 30 touchdowns in a season, as well as the first F&M and CC QB to throw for 3,000 yards in a season.

Preseason Rankings: Franklin & Marshall's football team entered the 2010 season as the 25th ranked team in the nation according to *The Sporting News*.

Centennial Poll Position: F&M was ranked second in the Centennial Conference preseason football poll and collected seven of the 20 first place votes. Only reigning Centennial Champions Johns Hopkins finished ahead of F&M in the poll with 11 first place nods.

Captain's Choice: Seniors **Jay Ridinger** and **Mark Surma (Philadelphia, Pa. / Central)** will lead the 123rd edition of Diplomats football through the 2010 campaign.

Individual Preseason Nods: Tight end, **Michael Deutch (Sussex, N.J. / Vernon)**, and defensive lineman, **Mark Surma**, were named preseason All-Americans by D3proday.com. Surma was named to the third team, while Deutch earned honorable mention. The team is limited to seniors.

An All-Centennial Second Team pick in 2009, Surma served as the Diplomats' lone junior captain. He will reprise the role in 2010 following a season in which he posted 33 tackles, including four sacks. He forced a fumble as well.

Deutch was an All-Centennial First Team choice in 2010. He wrapped up the season with 35 receptions for 375 yards. He caught nine touchdown passes in 2009 to help the Diplomats to a 9-2 mark and the ECAC South-Atlantic title.

All-Conference Returnees: Four of F&M's eight All-Centennial selections from 2009 return to the gridiron for the 2010 season. Tight end, **Michael Deutch**, is the only returning first team choice, while quarterback **John Harrison**, inside linebacker **Sam Massaro**, and defensive lineman, **Mark Surma** are returning second team choices. Deutch made his first All-Centennial appearance following a regular season in which he caught 35 passes for 375 yards and nine touchdowns. His nine, six-point grabs set the Conference's single season record for touchdown catches by a tight end. The record had been owned by a Diplomat, Mike Sernatinger, since 1995. Harrison established dozens of records at Franklin & Marshall and in the Centennial Conference this season. His 276 completions, 3,096 yards, and 32 passing touchdowns are all school and Centennial Conference single season records. He turned in Franklin & Marshall's second-ever 400-yard passing effort with 404 yards and five touchdowns - also a school single game record - at McDaniel. Harrison threw for five touchdowns on two occasions during the 2009 season. A freshman in 2009, Massaro started at middle linebacker from the outset earning Centennial Conference Player of the Week honors after the season-opener. Despite missing the final game of the season to injury, Massaro led F&M in tackles with 22 more than the next closest player. His 70 stops included 43 unassisted efforts, eight for losses, four of which were sacks. Massaro tied for the team lead in interceptions with Lovett, Kellar and Ty Savastio. Each had three on the season. Surma made his first All-Centennial appearance. He recorded 33 tackles, including 17 solo stops this season to go with four sacks and a forced fumble.
