Today's Game: Franklin & Marshall (4-1, 3-1 CC) at Moravian (2-4, 2-3 CC)

Series History: Today's game marks the 23rd renewal of a series that began in Lancaster in 1932 with a 21-7 F&M win. It marks the fourth meeting between these schools under the auspices of the Centennial Conference. Moravian had won the first two Centennial contests between these schools, marking only the second time the Hounds have won consecutive contests against F&M, but the Diplomats bounced back last year with a 29-13 win on Sponaugle-Williamson Field.

Franklin & Marshall holds a 17-5 edge in a series in the previously on-again off-again relationship. The first eight games were spread out over 42 seasons. The teams met for 11-consecutive seasons (1972-1982) competing in the MAC. F&M held a 15-1 lead at the end of that streak.

F&M Last Week: F&M was idle last week. Two weeks ago, the Diplomats found themselves in an early hole for the second time in as many weeks. After falling behind Susquehanna 17-5, F&M outscored its hosts 36-3 for a 41-20 win.

Moravian Last Week: Gettysburg rushed for 270 yards and scored all four of its touchdowns on the ground as the Bullets pulled away late to earn their first home and Centennial Conference victory of the season, defeating Moravian College 33-21. Gettysburg, which never trailed after jumping to a 16-0 lead, received 64 rushing yards and a career-high three touchdowns from senior tailback Anthony DeSalva while senior tailback Jamel Mutunga led all players with 82 yards rushing and one touchdown.

Associate Members: Moravian is one of three associate members of the Centennial Conference. The Hounds joined the league with Juniata in 2007, with Susquehanna joining the fray this season. Entering today's game, F&M is 6-2 against the league's associate members. Moravian accounts for both of the losses.

After the Bye: F&M is 2-0 coming off of the bye week in the John Troxell era. Each of those wins came over the past two years. The Diplomats played ten-straight in 2006 and 2007. F&M's walloped Ursinus 51-13 at home following the 2008 off week. Last year F&M toppled the Bears 21-14 in Collegeville following the week off.

The Diplomats Road Show: F&M has won six of its last seven road games. Today's game is the second of three-straight on the road and the first of consecutive trips to the Lehigh Valley. The Diplomats are back in the Valley next week at Muhlenberg.

Picks Lead to Pick of the Week: Franklin & Marshall inside linebacker, **Sam Massaro (Old Tappan, N.J./ Northern Valley Old Tappan)**, was named the Centennial Conference (CC) Player of the Week for his role in the Diplomats' 41-20 victory at Susquehanna two weeks back.

Massaro put his stamp on the win victory over the Crusaders, ending three of the Crusader's second half possessions on his own. The sophomore picked off the Crusaders' quarterbacks three times tying the F&M record for interceptions in a game. The first set up Harrison's 23-yard toss touchdown to Diggs. Massaro took care of scoring on his own with the second pick, rumbling over 30-yards of open field for the first interception touchdown return of his career. His third pick sealed Susquehanna's fate and tied him with Dan Howley, who picked three against three against Carnegie Mellon in 1972, and Joe Cavallo, who hawked three from Johns Hopkins in 1987, for the school record. Massaro also recorded a team-high nine tackles in the win.

The Player of the Week honor is the second of the sophomore's career. He earned his first Player of the Week award following the first game of his career at Washington & Lee. In that contest, Massaro recorded eight tackles and returned an interception 30-yards. He has been named to the Centennial's Weekly Honor Roll three times in his career for a total of five honors in 14 opportunities. Massaro has six career interceptions, tying him for 21st on the career charts at F&M. He is nine away from Kevin Waninger's '79 record of 15.

Sounding Like a Broken Record: **John Harrison (Flourtown, Pa. / La Salle College HS)** now owns career records for completed passes (504), passing yards (5,660), passing touchdowns (59), completion percentage (65.3), and pass efficiency rating (145.4). He is the only Diplomat to complete 500 passes in his career.

On Harrison's Horizon: The last big school record in **Harrison's** sights is the touchdowns responsible for mark. The fleet-footed Joe Coviello '77 was responsible for 69 touchdowns between 1973 and 1976. Coviello threw 52 touchdowns and rushed for 17 more. Harrison is currently responsible for 59, all through the air.

Movin' On Up: **Jay Ridinger (Lititz, Pa. / Manheim Twp.)** recorded his third 100-plus yard receiving effort at Susquehanna. The senior rumbled 68-yards for the longest touchdown of his career en route to a six-catch, 114-yard effort. In the process, he jumped up to seventh in career receiving yards at 1,746. He needs 11 yards today to match David McKenzie '00 and 60 to match Matt Wagaman '04 for fifth on the list at 1806.

Ridinger is currently fifth in career catches with 141, needing eight to catch up with Zac Kraft '93. He is also fifth in touchdown receptions with 19. Two touchdowns today would put him on par with Bob Kaithern '75 for fourth on the list.

Kaschak's Climb: **During the win at Susquehanna, John Kaschak (Lake Hoptacong, N.J. / Jefferson Twp.)** became the eighth Diplomat rusher to gain 1,500 career yards. A 75-yard effort today would make him the sixth Diplomat to rush for 1,600 yards. A 57-yard game would tie him with Ken Scalet '89 for seventh on the career rushing yards chart, while a 68-yard day would tie him for sixth in career rushing yards with Ted D'Amico '76.

Safety Dance: **When C.T. Marsh (Phoenix, Md. / Loyola-Blakefield)** dragged down Susquehanna's Greg Tellish in the end zone, it was the junior's second tackle for loss on consecutive plays. It was also the Diplomats' first safety since November 3rd, 2007's 19-11 win at Johns Hopkins. Marsh finished the game at Susquehanna with three tackles for losses, including a sack. Marsh has recorded at least one sack in each of the past four games. He leads the Diplomats' defense with five sacks this season, bringing him to 11.5 on the junior's career. He is tied for 20th on F&M's career sack list. Matt DesChamps '93 holds F&M's career sack record at 25.5. Marsh leads the 2010 Diplomats with a dozen tackles for losses, more than twice the next closest player on the roster.

Sack Attack: Franklin & Marshall has recorded 13.5 sacks over the past two weeks. The Diplomats rolled up seven sacks against Juniata two weeks ago. That was the second best effort in dropping the quarterback in the new millennium. The Diplomats posted eight sacks in last year's win over Ursinus. How do you follow a seven-sack performance against Juniata? You pin your ears back and put up 6.5 more the following week. Through five games this season, 10 different players have combined for 18 sacks costing the opposition 130 yards. One more will already match the second best season of sacks in the Troxell era. The 2007 Diplomats got to the quarterback 19 times. Last year, Troxell's team reset the highwater mark of his era with 28 sacks in 11 games.

Diggs Doubles Up: Wide receiver, Jarrell Diggs (Baltimore / Gilman) recorded two touchdown catches at Susquehanna, marking the first time in his career he caught a pair of touchdowns in the same game. He had hit for the cycle against Ursinus as a freshman, throwing a touchdown pass, rushing for a touchdown, and receiving a touchdown. It is believed to be the only time a player in F&M's history has accomplished that feat.

Struss Test: When cornerback **Ty Savastio (Downingtown, Pa. / Downingtown East)** went down with an injury, **Jonathan Struss (Fairfield, N.J. / West Essex)**, in his fifth career start, became the most experienced cornerback on the Diplomats roster. He broke up three Susquehanna passes for F&M, moving him to the top of the list in pass breakups this season at five. Savastio and **Kurt Rogers (Sudbury, Mass. / Lincoln-Sudbury)** have each broken up four.

It's a Good Thing it is Not How You Start: F&M has turned the ball over on its first possession in each of the past three games. Making matters worse, all three of the turnovers came on the F&M side of the field resulting in easy early points for Susquehanna and Juniata. The Diplomats defense held Dickinson to a missed field goal attempt at the start of the streak three weeks ago. Despite the early miscues, F&M is 3-0 in the games where the first possession has ended with a turnover.

F&M's Provost: **Kenny Provost (Petoskey, Mich. / Petoskey)** gave Juniata fits all day when the team squared off in September. The sophomore recorded a team-best and career-high nine tackles. Seven of his stops were solos. His three tackles for losses of 21 yards included a pair of sacks for losses of 19 yards.

Welcome to the TD Club: Freshman quarterback, E.J. Schneider tossed his first collegiate touchdown pass of the year to **Peter Gumas (Medfield, Mass. / Medfield)** in the fourth quarter of F&M's 55-13 win over Juniata. It was the first collegiate touchdown on both ends of the equation. Later in the quarter, **Jacob Kelly (San Diego / The Bishop's School)** rushed for his first collegiate touchdown, punching in from five yards out. **Donald Wiezik (River Vale, N.J. / Pascack Valley)** scooped and scored a on a fumble against Juniata for the Diplomats' second defensive touchdown of the season, but the first of Wiezik's career.

In the Black in the Red: Franklin & Marshall has scored on 18 of its 19 trips into the red zone this season. Of the red zone trips, 16 have ended with Diplomat touchdowns. Meanwhile, F&M has been stingy at the other end. Only ten of the opposition's 17 red zone forays have yielded points, and only six touchdowns have been scored from inside of the 20 against the Diplomats' defense.

Red Zone Turnovers: One of the reasons that teams don't score in the red zone is turnovers. F&M has ended five red zone opportunities by taking the football away. Four of the takeaways were interceptions, including freshman **Chase Andreassi's (Southampton, N.Y. / St. Anthony's)** red zone pick last week against Juniata. That was one of two takeaways for the Diplomats while their backs were to the wall. **Sam Massaro (Old Tappan, N.J. / Northern Valley Old Tappan)** forced a fumble on the one yard-line that was recovered by **Ty Savastio (Downingtown, Pa. / Downingtown East)**.

Study Effort: Sophomore **Jordan Studevan (Philadelphia, Pa. / William Penn Charter)** recorded the first half-sack and forced fumble of his career all in one fell swoop. He finished the sack that **Kyle Wengerter (Creskill, N.J. / Creskill)** had started by forcing the fumble that was recovered by Wiezik for the score. Wengerter recorded 1.5 sacks in the win over Juniata. It was the first multiple sack effort of his career.

F&M's 30 for 30: 30 different Diplomats recorded at least one defensive statistic during the win over Juniata. That ties the team-high in the Troxell set last year when 30 players recorded at least a tackle. 29 of the 30 players with stats last week registered a tackle. The only defensive player that had a stat, but not a tackle was Andreassi. His touchdown saving interception more than makes up for the fact.

Just an FYI: None of John Harrison's records would be possible if we weren't upright. F&M's offensive line gets it done.

Savastio the Savior: Ty Savastio saved F&M from the sting of two Dickinson touchdowns. Savastio picked off a Ricky Martz pass in the end zone in the first quarter, then broke up a Martz third down pass that was destined for six points.

Conestoga Grad Helps Grab Conestoga Wagon: Chris DeStefano (Berwyn, Pa. / Conestoga) went 5-for-5 on PATs Friday night. This is noteworthy because he was kicking for F&M. His effort marks the first time F&M has been perfect on PATs in a game the Diplomats have scored three or more touchdowns since last year's 21-14 win at Ursinus on October 10. Eight games have passed since that contest, seven of which saw F&M score three or more TDs. DeStefano also piled up five tackles (3 solo) in the win from his spot at safety.

He Tackles Too: You get the sense that senior tight end, **Michael Deutch (Sussex, N.J. / Vernon Twp.)** will do whatever is asked of him. Aside from his four receptions for 44-yards and a touchdown and his week one punting duties, Deutch recorded three open field tackles on kickoffs at Dickinson.

Ball Hogs: Franklin & Marshall held possessed the football for 17:48 of the second half at Dickinson, giving the Diplomats possession for 36:17. It was the most time F&M has held the ball through the three games played this season. Dickinson was only able to muster 92 yards of offense in the second half.

Despite the clock dominance in the second half, it was not the most greedy half of Diplomats' football this season. F&M held the ball for 23:27 of the first half in the win over Washington & Lee. The lopsided time of possession yielded lopsided statistics. F&M rolled up 312 yards of offense compared to Washington & Lee's four and took a 29-0 lead into the break.

Bear Hunter: C.T. Marsh has two multiple sack games to his credit. Both were against Ursinus. Marsh led all Diplomat tacklers with 10 stops, eight solo, against Ursinus. That effort included four tackles for losses of 23 yards, half of which were sacks for losses of 16 yards. That performance landed him on the Centennial Conference's Weekly Honor Roll. A year ago at Ursinus, Marsh recorded 1.5 sacks resulting in 11 yards of setbacks for the Bears.

575: Franklin & Marshall's win over Washington & Lee was the program's 575th victory.

Pick Wisely: Two of W&L's drives ended in the F&M end zone with F&M interceptions. **Nick Barbieri (Glen Mills, Pa. / Penncrest)** and **Chris DeStefano** each recorded their first career picks.

A Season of Firsts: In 2009, Harrison became the first F&M and CC QB to reach 250 completions in a season. He also became the first F&M and CC QB to throw 30 touchdowns in a season, as well as the first F&M and CC QB to throw for 3,000 yards in a season.

Preseason Rankings: Franklin & Marshall's football team entered the 2010 season as the 25th ranked team in the nation according to The Sporting News. F&M is also still receiving votes in the D3Football.com Top 25. The Diplomats are coming off of a 9-2 season, that concluded with a come-from-behind, 29-24 win over Wilkes in the ECAC South Atlantic Championship game.

Centennial Poll Position: F&M ranked second in the Centennial Conference preseason football poll and collected seven of the 20 first place votes. Only reigning Centennial Champions Johns Hopkins finished ahead of F&M in the poll with 11 first place nods.

Decorated Coach: John Troxell's fourth year ended on an upswing. The Diplomats mentor delivered a 9-2 record and an ECAC bowl win. He was named the Centennial Conference's Coach of the Year and was a national finalist for the highly coveted Liberty Mutual Coach of the Year Award, finishing in second place in fan voting. Troxell and his staff were also selected to coach the South Team offense in the D3 All-Star Classic.

Captain's Choice: Seniors Jay Ridinger and Mark Surma will lead the 123rd edition of Diplomats football through the 2010 campaign.

Individual Preseason Nods: Tight end, Michael Deutch, and defensive lineman, Mark Surma, were named preseason All-Americans by D3proday.com. Surma was named to the third team, while Deutch earned honorable mention. The team is limited to seniors. An All-Centennial Second Team pick in 2009, Surma served as the Diplomats' lone junior captain. He will reprise the role in 2010 following a season in which he posted 33 tackles, including four sacks. He forced a fumble as well.

Deutch was an All-Centennial First Team choice in 2010. He wrapped up the season with 35 receptions for 375 yards. He caught nine touchdown passes in 2009 to help the Diplomats to a 9-2 mark and the ECAC South-Atlantic title.

All-Conference Returnees: Four of F&M's eight All-Centennial selections from 2009 return to the gridiron for the 2010 season. Tight end, Michael Deutch, is the only returning first team choice, while quarterback John Harrison, inside linebacker Sam Massaro, and defensive lineman, Mark Surma are returning second team choices.

Deutch made his first All-Centennial appearance following a regular season in which he caught 35 passes for 375 yards and nine touchdowns. His nine, six-point grabs set the Conference's single season record for touchdown catches by a tight end. The record had been owned by a Diplomat, Mike Sernatinger, since 1995. Harrison established dozens of records at Franklin & Marshall and in the Centennial Conference this season. His 276 completions, 3,096 yards, and 32 passing touchdowns are all school and Centennial Conference single season records. He turned in Franklin & Marshall's second-ever 400-yard passing effort with 404 yards and five touchdowns - also a school single game record - at McDaniel. Harrison threw for five touchdowns on two occasions during the 2009 season. A freshman in 2009, Massaro started at middle linebacker from the outset earning Centennial Conference Player of the Week honors after the season-opener. Despite missing the final game of the season to injury, Massaro led F&M in tackles with 22 more than the next closest player. His 70 stops included 43 unassisted efforts, eight for losses, four of which were sacks. Massaro tied for the team lead in interceptions with Lovett, Kellar and Ty Savastio. Each had three on the season. Surma made his first All-Centennial appearance. He recorded 33 tackles, including 17 solo stops this season to go with four sacks and a forced fumble.

Trox Box

In 2009, Troxell guided the Diplomats to a 9-2 season that was capped by an ECAC South Atlantic Championship victory. Troxell was named the Centennial Conference's Coach of the Year and was one of five national finalists for the highly coveted Liberty Mutual Coach of the Year Award. The 9-2 season marked the Diplomats best campaign dating back to 1996.

Named the 39th coach in Franklin & Marshall football history on March 22, 2006, Troxell took the reins of the Diplomats following five seasons (2001-2005) as an assistant coach at Lafayette during which he served as video coordinator, running backs coach, recruiting coordinator and special teams coach for the 2004 and 2005 Patriot League champion Leopards.

During his tenure, he mentored 2004 Patriot League Offensive Player of the Year Joe McCourt '05 to a record-setting career. Under Troxell's tutelage, McCourt, the 2001 Patriot League Rookie of the Year, concluded his career as Lafayette's and the Patriot League's all-time leader with 50 rushing touchdowns, and second on the school's all-time rushing list with 4,474 yards while earning All-America honors in 2002 and 2004.

Named the Leopards' recruiting coordinator prior to the 2003 season, Troxell landed 24 freshmen for the 2005 season, including 10 who were all-state players. He joined the Lafayette staff after serving as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Muhlenberg College from 1997-2000.

He served as special teams coordinator (1997-99), quarterbacks and wide receivers coach (1997-2000) and offensive coordinator (2000) at Muhlenberg as the Mules went from a 1-9 season in 1997 to the Eastern College Athletic Conference title with a record of 9-2 in 2000. In 2000, his offense ranked 22nd in Division III and led the Centennial Conference in total offense (427.8 yards per game) while averaging 31.0 points per game.

In his first three seasons at Muhlenberg, Troxell coordinated the Mules' special teams. Under his guidance, Muhlenberg led Division III in kickoff returns. Josh Carter, Lafayette's offensive assistant in 2004, was the Football Gazette specialist of the year under Troxell's tutelage. He also coached the quarterbacks and receivers all four seasons, including Muhlenberg's all-time leading passer and Carter, the program's first Centennial Conference player of the year.

Troxell joined the Muhlenberg staff after serving as an assistant coach for three seasons at Columbia University. He assisted with the Lions' defensive backs from 1994-96, helping them record the third-best pass defense in Division I-AA in 1996. The assistant recruiting coordinator his final two seasons at Columbia, he was elevated to running backs coach in the spring of 1997.

A 1994 Lafayette graduate with a B.A. in government and law, Troxell was the starting free safety on the Leopards' 1992 Patriot League championship team and received the program's Unsung Hero Award as a senior. He went on to earn an M.A. in sociology and education from Columbia in 1997. A native of Phillipsburg, N.J., Troxell and his wife, Pamela, have two daughters: Summer and Capri.
