Today's Game: Franklin & Marshall (4-2, 3-2 CC) at Muhlenberg (5-1, 5-0 CC)

Series History: Today's game marks the 94th renewal of a series that began in Lancaster 108 years ago with a 69-0 F&M victory. The shutout was the first of nine-consecutive whitewashes spread out over 22 years. F&M took the first four, while Muhlenberg captured the next five. Shutouts are a staple of the series with 25 contests ending with at least one time posting a goose egg. In 1930, the teams held each other scoreless. Today's game marks the 51st meeting in Allentown. The series here is split evenly (see the complete series history on page 4).

The Last Meeting: Given a 13-0 edge, Franklin & Marshall's defense repeatedly came up with plays when needed to hold off Muhlenberg in a rain-soaked 20-7 Homecoming win. Two big pass plays gave F&M (6-1, 4-1 CC) a 13-0 jump in the first quarter, not too long before the field became a quagmire. The defense took over from there.

The Last Meeting in Allentown: John DeLuca rushed for 177 yards and a touchdown on 42 carries to lead #5 Muhlenberg to a 17-6 win over Franklin & Marshall. DeLuca carried the ball 12 times for 57 yards on an 11:27 drive that consumed most of the fourth quarter and ended with a 42-yard field goal by Mike Katz.

F&M Last Week: Joe Tegan's 31-yard dash to the end zone was the difference-maker as Moravian handed Franklin & Marshall a 24-17 loss in last Saturday's Centennial Conference (CC) football tilt. The run capped a four-play Greyhounds (3-4, 3-3 CC) race to the end zone after the Diplomats (4-2, 3-2 CC) had just knotted it up 17-17 late in the fourth quarter.

Muhlenberg Last Week: Muhlenberg extended its winning streak to five games with a 29-0 win at McDaniel. The Mules held the Terror to 143 total yards and seven first downs. McDaniel was limited to 22 rushing yards on 20 carries. Muhlenberg had significantly less trouble moving the football over land. Terrence Dandridge posted his fourth consecutive 100-yard effort with a career-high 140 yards

The Diplomats Road Show: F&M has won six of its last eight road games. Today's game is the last of three-straight on the road and the second of consecutive trips to the Lehigh Valley. The Diplomats head back to Lancaster for the Homecoming tilt with McDaniel, then close out the home slate with Johns Hopkins before wrapping up the regular season at Gettysburg.

Sack Streak: C.T. Marsh (Jr. / Phoenix, Md. / Loyola-Blakefield) recorded a sack for the fifth-straight game, moving him to 12.5 for his career, good enough for 17th on the charts at F&M. Only a dozen Diplomats have recorded 15 or more sacks in their career, with Matt DesCahmps '93 topping the list at 25.5. Marsh's 88 yards of losses on sacks ranks 11th in school history, while his 116 yards he has set the opposition back in all tackles for losses ranks fourth.

Diggs On a Roll: Wide receiver, **Jarrell Diggs (Jr. / Baltimore / Gilman)** has caught a touchdown in each of the Diplomats' past four games. It is the longest touchdown streak of the junior's career.

Diggs has hauled in at least one pass in each of his 27 career games, marking the longest active receptions streak on the roster and tenth longest streak among all active Division III players. He recorded two touchdown catches at Susquehanna, marking the first time in his career he caught a pair of touchdowns in the same game. He had hit for the cycle against Ursinus as a freshman, throwing a touchdown pass, rushing for a touchdown, and receiving a touchdown. It is believed to be the only time a player in F&M's history has accomplished that feat.

Diggs on the Books: During his two-touchdown day at Susquehanna, Diggs became the 19th Diplomat to reach the 1,000- receiving yard plateau at F&M. The next catch of his career will be the 85th, tying him with three Diplomats (including RB John Kaschak) for 15th in career receptions. Only nine Diplomats have 100 or more career receptions (including Jay Ridinger). Diggs has eight career touchdowns, needing one to tie Derek Boyce '05 for 20th on the career list at F&M.

On Streak Ends the Other Continues: Jay Ridinger (Sr. / Litz, Pa. / Manheim Twp.) came up three yards short of posting his third consecutive 100-yard game, but he did keep his streak of consecutive games with a reception alive. With his career-high nine-reception day at Moravian, Ridinger moved his streak to 23 games in a row with at least one catch. That is tied for the 16th longest active streak in DIII. He has posted multiple receptions in nine-straight games. He has caught at least one pass in 35 of his 37 career games. The last time Ridinger did not catch a pass in a game was during the 14-0 win over Juniata in September 2008. The Diplomats threw only 19 times for nine completions during the game, which was played in the remnants of a hurricane. It was one of two hurricane games that season. The first was against Washington & Lee, marking the only other game in Ridinger's career that he did not record at least one reception.

Ridinger's Run Up the Charts: Ridinger's 97-yard day at Moravian moved him into fifth on the career charts at F&M with 1,843 yards, while his nine receptions moved him up to fourth. He enters today's game with 150 receptions in his career, one more than Zac Kraft '94 and 60 fewer than the next guy on the chart, wide receivers coach, George Eager '10. He needs one touchdown reception to become the fifth Diplomat to catch 20 touchdowns in his career, and two to tie Bob Kaithern '75 for fourth. He is 16 shy of the record, 35, owned by Dale Amos '90. Amos holds ten on the field, with Eager second at 25.

Sounding Like a Broken Record: John Harrison (Flourtown, Pa. / La Salle College HS) owns career records for completed passes (538), passing yards (5,910), passing touchdowns (61), completion percentage (65.4), and pass efficiency rating (143.6). He is the only Diplomat to complete 500 passes in his career. He needs 90 yards to become F&M's first 6,000-yard passer, and the sixth in Centennial Conference history. He is within seven touchdowns of Ron Sermarini's (McDaniel 1996-1999) Centennial Conference record of 68. He has a total of 23.5 TFL.

On Harrison's Horizon: The last big school record in Harrison's sights is the touchdowns responsible for mark. The fleet-footed Joe Coviello '77 was responsible for 69 touchdowns between 1973 and 1976. Coviello threw 52 touchdowns and rushed for 17 more. Harrison is currently responsible for 61, all through the air.

Harrison on the CC Charts: Last week's 250-yard effort at Moravian was the 17th time that Harrison threw for 200-yards in a game. That tied him with Michael McCabe, who had 17 200-yard afternoons for Muhlenberg between 1997 and 2000. If he throws for 200 yards today, that will tie him with Ron Sermarini, he threw for 200

yards for Western Maryland (now McDaniel) 18 times between 1996 and 1999. Sermarini's predecessor, Brian Van Deusen, owns the most 200-yard passing days in the league's history having hit the mark 23 times. Van Deusen coached Diplomats' right guard, Zach Robinson, to the Maryland State Championship Game at River Hill High School. Harrison needs one more 300-yard day to tie Van Deusen for the second most 300-yard days in a career at seven. McCabe holds that record at eight.

Harrison's Tosses: Harrison tossed the ball a career-high 51 times at Moravian, tying the fifth most pass attempts on record at F&M. It was four throws less than the record owned by Dave Makson. Makson tossed 55 footballs against McDaniel in 2003. Harrison completed 34 passes, one fewer than the school record, 35 he connected against Washington & Lee in last year's season opener.

Seasonal Perspective: Harrison needs 43 yards to register the 16th season in which a Diplomat passer has thrown for 1,500 yards. He owns the record after last year's 3,096-yard season. His 15 touchdown passes in 2010 rank as the eight best season, 17 shy of his record set in 2009. His 66.2 completion percentage is the second best season on record, second only to the 69.0 he posted in 2009.

Kaschak's Climb: During the win at Susquehanna, **John Kaschak (Lake Hoptacong, N.J. / Jefferson Twp.)** became the eighth Diplomat rusher to gain 1,500 career yards. His 57-yard game at Moravian tied him with Ken Scalet '89 for seventh on the career rushing yards chart at 1,582. He needs 11 yards to tie him for sixth in career rushing yards with Ted D'Amico '76, while 18 yards would make him the sixth Diplomat rusher to 1,600 yards in his career.

Grade A in the Red Zone: Franklin & Marshall's offense has scored on 21 of 22, or 95% of its trips into the red zone in 2010. Of the 22 red zone appearances, 18 have ended with touchdowns. The Diplomats defense draws a line in the sand in the red zone. Of the 21 forays inside of F&M's 20, only 12 (57%) have resulted in opponents' scores. The defense has limited the opposition to seven touchdowns in the 21 trips.

One Away From 2K: F&M enters today's game sitting on 1,999 yards of total offense.

Trox Box

In 2009, Troxell guided the Diplomats to a 9-2 season that was capped by an ECAC South Atlantic Championship victory. Troxell was named the Centennial Conference's Coach of the Year and was one of five national finalists for the highly coveted Liberty Mutual Coach of the Year Award. The 9-2 season marked the Diplomats best campaign dating back to 1996.

Named the 39th coach in Franklin & Marshall football history on March 22, 2006, Troxell took the reins of the Diplomats following five seasons (2001-2005) as an assistant coach at Lafayette during which he served as video coordinator, running backs coach, recruiting coordinator and special teams coach for the 2004 and 2005 Patriot League champion Leopards.

During his tenure, he mentored 2004 Patriot League Offensive Player of the Year Joe McCourt '05 to a record-setting career. Under Troxell's tutelage, McCourt, the 2001 Patriot League Rookie of the Year, concluded his career as Lafayette's and the Patriot League's all-time leader with 50 rushing touchdowns, and second on the school's all-time rushing list with 4,474 yards while earning All-America honors in 2002 and 2004.

Named the Leopards' recruiting coordinator prior to the 2003 season, Troxell landed 24 freshmen for the 2005 season, including 10 who were all-state players. He joined the Lafayette staff after serving as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Muhlenberg College from 1997-2000.

He served as special teams coordinator (1997-99), quarterbacks and wide receivers coach (1997-2000) and offensive coordinator (2000) at Muhlenberg as the Mules went from a 1-9 season in 1997 to the Eastern College Athletic Conference title with a record of 9-2 in 2000. In 2000, his offense ranked 22nd in Division III and led the Centennial Conference in total offense (427.8 yards per game) while averaging 31.0 points per game.

In his first three seasons at Muhlenberg, Troxell coordinated the Mules' special teams. Under his guidance, Muhlenberg led Division III in kickoff returns. Josh Carter, Lafayette's offensive assistant in 2004, was the Football Gazette specialist of the year under Troxell's tutelage. He also coached the quarterbacks and receivers all four seasons, including Muhlenberg's all-time leading passer and Carter, the program's first Centennial Conference player of the year.

Troxell joined the Muhlenberg staff after serving as an assistant coach for three seasons at Columbia University. He assisted with the Lions' defensive backs from 1994-96, helping them record the third-best pass defense in Division I-AA in 1996. The assistant recruiting coordinator his final two seasons at Columbia, he was elevated to running backs coach in the spring of 1997.

A 1994 Lafayette graduate with a B.A. in government and law, Troxell was the starting free safety on the Leopards' 1992 Patriot League championship team and received the program's Unsung Hero Award as a senior. He went on to earn a M.A. in sociology and education from Columbia in 1997. A native of Phillipsburg, N.J., Troxell and his wife, Pamela, have two daughters: Summer and Capri.
