Today's Game: McDaniel (4-3, 3-3 CC) at Franklin & Marshall (5-2, 4-2 CC)

Series History: Overall: F&M leads 25-16-2 | In Lancaster: F&M leads 13-9-2 | In Centennial: 17-10

Franklin & Marshall will do battle with McDaniel for the 44th time in a series that dates back to 1904. F&M has won each of the last six meetings, including a pair of overtime games in Westminster. The six wins ties for the longest Diplomats' winning streak in the series. The Diplomats reeled off six-straight from 1984 to 1989. McDaniel owns the longest streak in the series having taken the seven meetings between 1997 and 2003. The Green Terror has not won in Lancaster since a 10-6 victory on Sponaugle-Williamson in 2002.

F&M Last Week: After watching Muhlenberg dominate the first half statistically, the Diplomats **Sam Massaro (Old Tappan, N.J. / Northern Valley Old Tappan)** blocked a punt and recovered it in the end zone to give F&M a 10-7 lead and swinging the momentum for good in a 17-7 win at Scotty Wood Stadium.

McDaniel Last Week: Al Desiderio caught three passes – all for touchdowns – accounting for 161 yards to lead No. 24 Ursinus in a 43-18 victory over McDaniel. Justin Decristofaro completed 23-of-38 passes for 367 yards with five touchdowns for the Bears, who took over sole possession of first place in the conference standings after Franklin & Marshall defeated previously conference unbeaten Muhlenberg, 17-7.

Tom Massucci threw for 215 yards for the Green Terror, completing 17 of 45 attempts with a pair of touchdown passes. Massucci went 4-for-9 for 75 yards in the first quarter, staking his team to a 13-7 lead through the game's first 10:44. However, three Ursinus touchdowns in the final 3:44 of the first half gave the hosts a 14-point halftime advantage.

The Last Meeting: John Harrison (Flourtown, Pa. / La Salle College HS) completed 26 passes for 404 yards and five touchdowns to lead Franklin & Marshall to a 41-20 win at McDaniel. The then-sophomore signal caller reset the school season records for completions, passing yards and touchdowns during the conference win. He also became the first Diplomat to throw for 400 yards since Dale Ritter did it in 1952 – 56 years, 11 months and 30 days earlier.

The Last Meeting in Lancaster: George Eager hauled in seven passes for 138 yards and a touchdown as Franklin & Marshall shutout McDaniel 20-0 on Sponaugle-Williamson Field on Homecoming Day. The shutout was F&M's third of the 2008 season, leaving the Diplomats unbeaten at home through four games on their turf.

Three Over .500: A win today would mark the first time Franklin & Marshall's head coach, John Troxell, climbed beyond a pair games over a .500 record in his career.

Block That Kick: Franklin & Marshall blocked two punts in the win at Muhlenberg. **Cameron Budde (Vero Beach, Fla. / St. Edward's)** blocked the first one, setting F&M up for its first three points of the game. **Sam Massaro** blocked a punt on the first series of the second half and recovered it for a touchdown. It was the first time since F&M blocked two kicks in the same game since 2007 against Juniata. In that game, the Diplomats blocked a punt and an extra point. The 2005 Diplomats managed two blocked kicks three times (at Bethany 9/3/05, at Johns Hopkins 10/8/05, and at McDaniel 10/29/05). In all three games, both blocked kicks were extra points.

Winning Ways: A win today would mark the 580th in Franklin & Marshall's history. It would also mark the 70th winning season in the program's history. The Diplomats have had five .500 seasons and 48 losing seasons. Perhaps most significantly, a win today would ensure the first pair of back-to-back winning seasons since the 1995 and 1996 seasons under Tom Gilburg. The Diplomats recorded 20 winning seasons during Gilburg's 28-year career, including a string of 15 seasons between 1975 and 1989. That was actually part of a stretch of 19-straight seasons with a winning record, dating back through the Bob Curtis years starting in 1971. The 1972 team earned the Lambert Trophy as the nation's top team in the East.

Homecoming Experience: Today's game marks the annual homecoming contest for F&M. It is the third straight homecoming game F&M has taken part in. The Diplomats lost to Moravian in their homecoming game two weeks ago, then spoiled Muhlenberg's homecoming last week. This is the second of three straight homecoming games for McDaniel as well. The Terror lost to Ursinus on homecoming last week and heads home for Hopkins next weekend.

The Right Choice: Franklin & Marshall has won the coin toss in six of seven games this season. The Diplomats are 4-2 in those games. When the Diplomats choose to receive the kickoff, they are 4-0. When F&M defers the choice, they are 0-2.

Massaro Named Player of the Week: Sam Massaro has been named the Centennial Conference's Special Teams Player of the Week for his role in Franklin & Marshall's 17-7 win at Muhlenberg on Saturday. Massaro blocked a punt and then recovered the football before it scooted out of the back of the end zone for the go-ahead touchdown in the Diplomats' road victory. F&M is the first team to beat Muhlenberg in Centennial play this season.

The Diplomats' sophomore earned his third Player of the Week honor of his career. His previous two awards came as the Defensive Player of the Week. He was named to the Centennial's Weekly Honor Roll for his ten tackle, one sack performance in Saturday's win.

Massaro was named the Centennial's Defensive Player of the Week following his three interception performance at Susquehanna at the start of October. He scored his first touchdown of the season in that game. His previous Defensive Player of the Week honor came after his first career game at Washington & Lee.

Wiez Guy: Donald Wiezik (River Vale, N.J. / Pascack Valley) had a much bigger game at Muhlenberg than the statistics would indicate. Wiezik shows three tackles, a half sack, and two pass breakups on his stat line. The stat line does not speak to the timeliness of his efforts. His half sack on a fourth and two ended a Muhlenberg drive. He later broke up passes on third and fourth down to end a late Muhlenberg offensive.

The Joy of Sacks: F&M ranks 24th in the nation in getting to the quarterback. **C.T. Marsh (Phoenix, Md. / Loyola-Blakefield)** recorded a half sack at Muhlenberg, extending his sack streak to six-straight games. He is up to 13 sacks on his career. He is tied with Glenn Pike '93 for 16th on the College's career charts. A full sack today would jump him up to a tie for 13th place on the list with Kevin Murray '92. Marsh's efforts reached well outside of sacks alone last week. He piled up ten tackles, six of which were solo stops in last week's win at Muhlenberg.

Field Goal Streak: **Chris DeStefano (Berwyn, Pa. / Conestoga)** has hit a field goal in each of F&M's last three games. His streak marks the first time since 2006 that the Diplomats have managed a field goal in three consecutive games. Paul Sousa '09 hit one in each of the last three games of the 2006 season. You have to go back to 2005 to find the last time F&M managed a field goal in four-straight games. Brandon Kline '08 booted at least one field goal in five straight. He hit on 11 of 12 field goals in that stretch.

Catch Streak: Wide receivers **Jarrell Diggs (Baltimore / Gilman)** and **Jay Ridinger (Lititz, Pa / Manheim Twp.)** each extended their streaks of games with a reception. Diggs has caught at least one football in each of his 28 career games to date. Ridinger is on a streak of 24 consecutive games with a catch.

More on Ridinger: After his career-high 11-catch afternoon at Muhlenberg, a day that yielded 113 yards for Ridinger, the senior has jumped to fourth in career receptions at F&M with 161 catches. He also moved within 44 yards of becoming only the fifth Diplomat to 2,000-yards receiving in his career. A touchdown catch today would be the 20th of his career, making him only the fifth Diplomat to that milestone. Ridinger has had a 100-yard receiving day in three of F&M's last four games. The other was a 97-yard afternoon.

More on Diggs: Diggs caught the 85th pass of his career, tying him for 16th in career receptions at F&M alongside Rusty Ward '69 and Andy Gilburg '01. Teammate, John Kaschak is one spot above him with 86 career catches. Diggs could climb as high as 11th on the career list with a day today. Brad Bate '87 currently occupies 11th with 90 receptions. Diggs needs 25 yards to become the 18th Diplomat to 1,100 career receiving yards.

Sounding Like a Broken Record: John Harrison owns career records for completed passes (554), passing yards (6,031), passing touchdowns (62), completion percentage (65.3), and pass efficiency rating (142.6). He is the only Diplomat to complete 500 passes in his career. Last week, he became F&M's first 6,000-yard passer, and the sixth in Centennial Conference history. He is within six touchdowns of Ron Sermarini's (McDaniel 1996-1999) Centennial Conference record of 68.

On Harrison's Horizon: The last big school record in Harrison's sights is the touchdowns responsible for mark. The fleet-footed Joe Coviello '77 was responsible for 69 touchdowns between 1973 and 1976. Coviello threw 52 touchdowns and rushed for 17 more. Harrison is currently responsible for 62, all through the air.

Harrison on the CC Charts: The 250-yard effort at Moravian two weeks back was the 17th time that Harrison threw for 200-yards in a game. That tied him with Michael McCabe, who had 17 200-yard afternoons for Muhlenberg between 1997 and 2000. If he throws for 200 yards today, that will tie him with Ron Sermarini, who threw for 200 yards for Western Maryland (now McDaniel) 18 times between 1996 and 1999. Sermarini's predecessor, Brian Van Deusen, owns the most 200-yard passing days in the league's history having hit the mark 23 times. Harrison needs one more 300-yard day to tie Van Deusen for the second most 300-yard days in a career at seven. McCabe holds that record at eight.

Kaschak's Climb: During the win at Susquehanna, **John Kaschak (Lake Hoptacong, N.J. / Jefferson Twp.)** became the eighth Diplomat rusher to gain 1,500 career yards. Last week, he became the sixth Diplomat rusher to 1,600 yards in his career.

Sibling Rivalry: Freshman Phil Barbieri (Glen Mills, Pa. / Penncrest) recorded his first career interception and pass breakup at Muhlenberg last week. Both he and his brother, **Nick (Glen Mills, Pa. / Penncrest)** now have an interception on the season. Nick got his in the season opening win against Washington & Lee. Phil recorded six tackles in the win at Muhlenberg. Nick had three.

Hunter the Punter: Devin Hunter (Colingdale, Pa. / Academy Park) was booming kicks at Muhlenberg. His five punts traveled 45.4 yards on average, including a long of 56. The 56 yard punt landed in the back of the end zone and actually sailed about 65 yards in the air.

Coffin Corner Quick Kicks: John Harrison has an abundance of passing records to his credit, but he is making his mark as a punter as well. Harrison has quick kicked three times this season, dropping all three inside of the 20, and leaving two on the one yardline this year. The other went to the 16. First Drive Over 75: Muhlenberg's 99-yard scoring drive, the only Mules' scoring drive of the day, was the longest drive for the Mules of the 2010 season and the longest drive F&M has allowed in 2010. It was the first drive longer than 75 yards F&M has allowed this season. The Diplomats have only allowed the opposition 11 drives longer than half of the field this season and have gone a pair of games without allowing any. Juniata had the most drives longer than 50 yards with three on the day.

Four Down Territory: Franklin & Marshall has stuffed the last eight fourth down conversions attempted against the Diplomats, including Muhlenberg's five attempts last weekend. The Diplomats' opponents have converted just a third of their fourth down attempts, gaining a first down six times in 18 tries. By contrast, the Diplomats have turned a dozen of their 18 fourth down attempts into first downs, including all three attempts at Muhlenberg. F&M has converted at least one fourth down attempt this season with the exception of the Washington & Lee win, when the Diplomats never went for it on fourth down.

Red Zone Diplomacy: Franklin & Marshall has scored points on 23-of-24 red zone trips this season, cashing in on each visit in all but one game. F&M was 2-for-2 in the red zone in Allentown. The Mules, were 1-of-2, and join F&M's other seven opponents with at least one failed trip into the red zone. F&M turns 95.8 percent of its trips inside of the 20 into points, while the defense has only allowed the opposition to cash in on 56.5 percent of theirs.

Trox Box

In 2009, Troxell guided the Diplomats to a 9-2 season that was capped by an ECAC South Atlantic Championship victory. Troxell was named the Centennial Conference's Coach of the Year and was one of five national finalists for the highly coveted Liberty Mutual Coach of the Year Award. The 9-2 season marked the Diplomats best campaign dating back to 1996.

Named the 39th coach in Franklin & Marshall football history on March 22, 2006, Troxell took the reins of the Diplomats following five seasons (2001-2005) as an assistant coach at Lafayette during which he served as video coordinator, running backs coach, recruiting coordinator and special teams coach for the 2004 and 2005 Patriot League champion Leopards.

During his tenure, he mentored 2004 Patriot League Offensive Player of the Year Joe McCourt '05 to a record-setting career. Under Troxell's tutelage, McCourt, the 2001 Patriot League Rookie of the Year, concluded his career as Lafayette's and the Patriot League's all-time leader with 50 rushing touchdowns, and second on the school's all-time rushing list with 4,474 yards while earning All-America honors in 2002 and 2004.

Named the Leopards' recruiting coordinator prior to the 2003 season, Troxell landed 24 freshmen for the 2005 season, including 10 who were all-state players. He joined the Lafayette staff after serving as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Muhlenberg College from 1997-2000.

He served as special teams coordinator (1997-99), quarterbacks and wide receivers coach (1997-2000) and offensive coordinator (2000) at Muhlenberg as the Mules went from a 1-9 season in 1997 to the Eastern College Athletic Conference title with a record of 9-2 in 2000. In 2000, his offense ranked 22nd in Division III and led the Centennial Conference in total offense (427.8 yards per game) while averaging 31.0 points per game.

In his first three seasons at Muhlenberg, Troxell coordinated the Mules' special teams. Under his guidance, Muhlenberg led Division III in kickoff returns. Josh Carter, Lafayette's offensive assistant in 2004, was the Football Gazette specialist of the year under Troxell's tutelage. He also coached the quarterbacks and receivers all four seasons, including Muhlenberg's all-time leading passer and Carter, the program's first Centennial Conference player of the year.

Troxell joined the Muhlenberg staff after serving as an assistant coach for three seasons at Columbia University. He assisted with the Lions' defensive backs from 1994-96, helping them record the third-best pass defense in Division I-AA in 1996. The assistant recruiting coordinator his final two seasons at Columbia, he was elevated to running backs coach in the spring of 1997.

A 1994 Lafayette graduate with a B.A. in government and law, Troxell was the starting free safety on the Leopards' 1992 Patriot League championship team and received the program's Unsung Hero Award as a senior. He went on to earn a M.A. in sociology and education from Columbia in 1997. A native of Phillipsburg, N.J., Troxell and his wife, Pamela, have two daughters: Summer and Capri.
