Today's Game: Johns Hopkins (5-3, 5-2 CC) at Franklin & Marshall (6-2, 5-2 CC)

Series History: Johns Hopkins and Franklin & Marshall meet for the 62nd time in a series that began in Baltimore with a 10-3 F&M win in 1912. The Diplomats hold a 34-25-2 lead in the series and a 16-12 lead in Lancaster.

Since Centennial Conference play began in 1983, Johns Hopkins owns a 15-12 lead, including a record of 8-5 in Lancaster. Hopkins had won ten straight over F&M leading up to the 2007 meeting, a 19-11 F&M win. That was Hopkins' longest streak in the series. F&M owns the longest streak between the two teams taking 17 matchups between 1971 and 1988. The Jays have taken both meetings since F&M's 2007 win.

The Last Meeting: Andrew Kase rushed 34 times for 202 yards and three touchdowns to lead JHU to a 51-13 win. Kase became the fourth collegiate player in Maryland history to rush for 4,000 yards in his career. His work on the ground helped Hopkins to seven third down conversions on a dozen attempts.

F&M quarterback, **John Harrison (Flourtown, Pa. / La Salle College HS)**, was sacked six times and under pressure throughout. He still finished the day with 275-yards and two touchdowns on a 27-of-41 effort. He was picked off twice in the loss. **Mike Deutch (Vernon, N.J. / Sussex Twp.)** caught eight passes for 95 yards and a first quarter touchdown. **Jay Ridinger (Lititz, Pa. / Manheim Twp.)** had two receptions for 21 yards and a third quarter touchdown. George Eager had six receptions for 72 yards. **Jarrell Diggs (Baltimore / Gilman)** had six catches for 60 yards.

The Last Meeting in Lancaster: A.J. Albert intercepted John Harrison's two point conversion pass in the waning moments of the fourth quarter to seal a 26-25 Johns Hopkins win over Franklin & Marshall. The Diplomats gambled in playing for the win and lost, however, they recovered the onside kick with 27 seconds left in the game for another crack. With F&M working without the aid of any time-outs, Hopkins closed the door on the Diplomats after three plays, tackling Ryan Murray on the Jay's 41-yardline leading to the expiration of the clock.

Johns Hopkins Last Week: Johns Hopkins scored touchdowns on its first four possessions of the game and got record-breaking performances from several players as the Blue Jays raced past Juniata, 48-0, at Homewood Field. The Blue Jays led 31-0 at the half and the Eagles never got inside the JHU 20-yard line as Hopkins won its second-straight game.

Sam Wernick, who has scored seven touchdowns in his last two games, picked up his school season record 13th touchdown. He and senior Tucker Michels passed the 2,000-yard plateau. Tomlin became Johns Hopkins' career passing leader as he threw for 316 yards to pass current Blue Jay head coach Jim Margraff. Tomlin has now thrown for 6,702 yards to break Margraff's record of 6,669. In all he was 19-of-27 for the 316 yards with all three of his scoring tosses going to Wernick.

F&M Last Week: Chris DeStefano kicked a 37-yard field goal to knot the homecoming fracas with McDaniel at 28-28 with 3:57 left. With seven seconds left in the game, he sailed a 30-yard field goal between the up-rights to deliver the Diplomats a 31-28 win over the Green Terror. **John Harrison** set school records for pass attempts (60), completions (42), and passing yards (447). It marked the second time in his career he topped the 400-yard passing mark. The first was against McDaniel in 2009. It was only the third time in F&M history that a quarterback threw for more than 400-yards. **Jarrell Diggs** had 10 catches for 139 yards, while **Michael Deutch** had seven catches for 120 yards. Deutch's final catch accounted for the last 25 yards that gave Harrison the record and set up the DeStefano game-winning kick.

1,000: Johns Hopkins is playing its 1,000th game of football this afternoon. F&M is playing its 1,086th.

580: The Diplomats homecoming win over McDaniel was the 580th victory in program history. It also ensured the 70th winning season in the program's history and the first pair of back-to-back winning seasons since the 1995 and 1996 seasons under Tom Gilburg.

In the Black: Last Saturday's win put Franklin & Marshall's head coach, John Troxell, three games over a .500 record for the first time in his career.

In the Red: Franklin & Marshall has scored points on 28-of-30 red zone trips this season. F&M turns 93 percent of its trips inside of the 20 into points, while the defense has only allowed the opposition to cash in on 62 percent, or 11-of-26, of theirs.

The Right Choice: Franklin & Marshall has won the coin toss in seven of eight games this season. The Diplomats are 5-2 in those games. When the Diplomats choose to receive the opening kickoff, they are 5-0. When F&M defers the choice, they are 0-2.

Four Down Territory: Franklin & Marshall has stuffed the last nine fourth down conversions attempted against the Diplomats, including Muhlenberg's five attempts two weeks ago and McDaniel's lone attempt last week. The Diplomats' opponents have converted less than a third of their fourth down attempts, gaining a first down six times in 19 tries. By contrast, the Diplomats have turned 15 of their 21 fourth down attempts into first downs, including all three attempts against both Muhlenberg and McDaniel. F&M has converted at least one fourth down attempt in every game this season with the exception of the Washington & Lee win, when the Diplomats never went for it on fourth down.

DePlayer of the Week: For the second time in as many weeks, Franklin & Marshall produced the Centennial Conference's Special Teams Player of the Week. **Chris DeStefano** took the honor this time around after booting a pair of field goals in the final four minutes of the 31-28 win over McDaniel. His first kick, a 37-yard field goal, marked the first time since the 2007 meeting with Johns Hopkins that F&M kicked a field goal from beyond 35-yards out. It extended F&M's streak of games with a field goal to four-straight. It is the first time since 2005 that F&M has hit a field goal in four consecutive games. Brandon Kline '08 booted at least one field goal in five straight. He hit on 11 of 12 field goals in that stretch.

Catch Streak: Wide receivers **Jarrell Diggs** and **Jay Ridinger** each extended their streaks of games with a reception during the win over McDaniel. Diggs has caught at least one football in each of his 29 career games

to date. Ridinger is on a streak of 25 consecutive games with a catch.

More on Diggs: Diggs' 10-catch, 139-yard performance (both career highs) against McDaniel bumped him to 17th in career receiving yards at F&M with 1,214 and 11th in career receptions at 95. Diggs has two 100-plus yards receiving days on his career. Both came against McDaniel.

More on Ridinger: Caught a career-high 11 passes for the second consecutive week. His 50-yards receiving put him over the 2,000-yard plateau (2,016). He is the fifth Diplomat to hit that mark in his career. He sits fifth on the career receiving yards chart, 144-yards behind Zac Kraft '94. Ridinger is also fourth in career receptions with 172 catches, 38 receptions behind college and high school teammate, George Eager, F&M's current receivers coach.

More on Deutch: Deutch's seven-catch, 120-yard afternoon marked the first 100-yard afternoon of his career, topping his previous career-high 95 yards on a career-high eight catches last year against Johns Hopkins. Deutch owns the College and Centennial career records for touchdowns by a tight end with 12, and is third behind Mike Sernatinger '97 and Andy Gilburg '01 in career receiving yards at the position. He needs 25 yards to catch Gilburg at 940, and 340 to catch Sernatinger at 1,255.

Two to 100: Deutch and Diggs 100-yard days marked the first time that two Diplomats piled up 100-plus receiving yards on the same day since Diggs and George Eager pulled the feat at McDaniel last year.

Sounding Like a Broken Record: With 18 passes today, **John Harrison** will own the record for career passing attempts. He already owns career records for completed passes (596), passing yards (6,478), passing touchdowns (64), completion percentage (65.6), and pass efficiency rating (141.8). He is the only Diplomat to complete 500 passes in his career. At Muhlenberg, he became F&M's first 6,000-yard passer, and the sixth in Centennial Conference history. He is within four touchdown tosses of Ron Sermarini's (McDaniel 1996-1999) Centennial Conference record of 68.

On Harrison's Horizon: The last big school record in Harrison's sights is the touchdowns responsible for mark. The fleet-footed Joe Coviello '77 was responsible for 69 touchdowns between 1973 and 1976. Coviello threw 52 touchdowns and rushed for 17 more. Harrison is currently responsible for 65, all but one through the air.

One by Land: Harrison is responsible for 65 touchdowns in his collegiate career, but his one-yard plunge against McDaniel marked his first trip into the end zone of the junior's career.

Harrison on the CC Charts: The 447-yard effort against McDaniel was the 18th time that Harrison threw for 200-yards in a game. That tied him with Ron Sermarini, who threw for 200 yards for Western Maryland (now McDaniel) 18 times between 1996 and 1999. Sermarini's predecessor, Brian Van Deusen, owns the most 200-yard passing days in the league's history having hit the mark 23 times. Harrison also tied Van Deusen for the second most 300-yard days in a career at seven. Muhlenberg's Michael McCabe (1997-2000) holds that record at eight. Harrison's second career 400-yard day tied him with McCabe for most 400-yard days in Centennial history.

Phil's Pair: Phil Barbieri's (Glen Mills, Pa. / Penncrest) pair of picks marks the first time since Susquehanna that a Diplomat stole two or more passes in a game (Sam Massaro had three against Susquehanna). Barbieri also piled up 11 tackles in the win. He was named to the Centennial's Weekly Honor Roll for the effort.

Sack Streak at Seven: C.T. Marsh (Phoenix, Md. / Loyola-Blakefield) recorded a sack against McDaniel, extending his sack streak to seven-straight games. He is up to 14 sacks on his career. He is tied with Kevin Murray '92 for 13th in career sacks at F&M. A sack today would tie him with Joseph Procida '88 for 12th on the list at 15. It would also tie him with five other players for 17th in sacks in a season at 8.5. Only 11 Diplomats have gotten to the quarterback 10 times in a year. Chris Lagos piled up 17 sacks in 1993 for the F&M record.

Block That Kick, Redux: Franklin & Marshall blocked two punts in each of the last two games. Cameron Budde (Vero Beach, Fla. / St. Edward's) blocked the first one at Muhlenberg, setting F&M up for its first three points of the game. Sam Massaro (Old Tappan, N.J. / Northern Valley Old Tappan) blocked a punt on the first series of the second half of that game and recovered it for a touchdown.

It was the first time since F&M blocked two kicks in the same game since 2007 against Juniata. In that game, the Diplomats blocked a punt and an extra point. F&M only had to wait a week for a repeat performance with Deutch blocking a pair on his own. The 2005 Diplomats managed two blocked kicks three times (at Bethany 9/3/05, at Johns Hopkins 10/8/05, and at McDaniel 10/29/05). In all three games, both blocked kicks were extra points.

Troxell Box

In 2009, Troxell guided the Diplomats to a 9-2 season that was capped by an ECAC South Atlantic Championship victory. Troxell was named the Centennial Conference's Coach of the Year and was one of five national finalists for the highly coveted Liberty Mutual Coach of the Year Award. The 9-2 season marked the Diplomats best campaign dating back to 1996.

Named the 39th coach in Franklin & Marshall football history on March 22, 2006, Troxell took the reins of the Diplomats following five seasons (2001-2005) as an assistant coach at Lafayette during which he served as video coordinator, running backs coach, recruiting coordinator and special teams coach for the 2004 and 2005 Patriot League champion Leopards.

During his tenure, he mentored 2004 Patriot League Offensive Player of the Year Joe McCourt '05 to a record-setting career. Under Troxell's tutelage, McCourt, the 2001 Patriot League Rookie of the Year, concluded his career as Lafayette's and the Patriot League's all-time leader with 50 rushing touchdowns, and second on the school's all-time rushing list with 4,474 yards while earning All-America honors in 2002 and 2004.

Named the Leopards' recruiting coordinator prior to the 2003 season, Troxell landed 24 freshmen for the 2005 season, including 10 who were all-state players. He joined the Lafayette staff after serving as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Muhlenberg College from 1997-2000.

He served as special teams coordinator (1997-99), quarterbacks and wide receivers coach (1997-2000) and offensive coordinator (2000) at Muhlenberg as the Mules went from a 1-9 season in 1997 to the Eastern College Athletic Conference title with a record of 9-2 in 2000. In 2000, his offense ranked 22nd in Division III and led the Centennial Conference in total offense (427.8 yards per game) while averaging 31.0 points per game.

In his first three seasons at Muhlenberg, Troxell coordinated the Mules' special teams. Under his guidance, Muhlenberg led Division III in kickoff returns. Josh Carter, Lafayette's offensive assistant in 2004, was the Football Gazette specialist of the year under Troxell's tutelage. He also coached the quarterbacks and receivers all four seasons, including Muhlenberg's all-time leading passer and Carter, the program's first Centennial Conference player of the year.

Troxell joined the Muhlenberg staff after serving as an assistant coach for three seasons at Columbia University. He assisted with the Lions' defensive backs from 1994-96, helping them record the third-best pass defense in Division I-AA in 1996. The assistant recruiting coordinator his final two seasons at Columbia, he was elevated to running backs coach in the spring of 1997.

A 1994 Lafayette graduate with a B.A. in government and law, Troxell was the starting free safety on the Leopards' 1992 Patriot League championship team and received the program's Unsung Hero Award as a senior. He went on to earn an M.A. in sociology and education from Columbia in 1997. A native of Phillipsburg, N.J., Troxell and his wife, Pamela, have two daughters: Summer and Capri.
