Today's Game: Juniata (0-3, 0-3 CC) at Franklin & Marshall (2-1, 1-1 CC)

Series History: Today's game marks the seventh time these schools have convened on the gridiron and the fourth time since Juniata attained associate membership status in the Centennial Conference. F&M has won all three meetings since the Eagles have landed in the league. Prior to that, the home team had won each meeting. F&M's 27-12 win in Huntingdon in 2007 rekindled the rivalry after 21 years and ended the home team dominance. The first two fracas were played in Lancaster - 61 years apart. The Diplomats won the first game between the schools played back on October 18, 1924, by a 27-0 margin. It wasn't until September 14, 1985 that the institutions reconvened, again on Sponaugle-Williamson, for a 21-0 Diplomats victory. The following year in Huntingdon, the Eagles scored their first points against F&M, picking up a 21-11 win on September 13.

The Last Meeting: George Eager caught six passes for 141 yards and three touchdowns to lead Franklin & Marshall to a 34-7 win at Juniata. Eager did all of his dirty work in a 34-0 first half before joining the starters on the bench for the second half. The Diplomats' starting signal caller, John Harrison, did not take a snap in the second half. He still managed to post his third consecutive 300-yard day. He racked up 317 yards and three touchdowns on a 19-of-26 afternoon.

The Last Meeting in Lancaster: John Kaschak rushed for 161 yards and a touchdown to lead Franklin & Marshall to a 14-0 win. Kaschak rushed 42 times, making him the second busiest back in a single-game in Franklin & Marshall history. He was one touch short of the record 43 rushes posted by John Seiber in 1979. His three-yard touchdown plunge midway through the third quarter eliminated any doubt about the outcome. Ryan Murray gave F&M the only score it needed in the closing minute of the first half. His two-yard touchdown reception from John Harrison capped a 29-yard drive, cashing in on one of Juniata's two lost fumbles in the game.

F&M Last Week: John Kaschak (Lake Hoptacong, N.J. / Jefferson Twp.) pounded out 129 yards and a pair of touchdowns on 24 carries to lead Franklin & Marshall to a 35-26 win at Dickinson Friday night. The Diplomats departed Carlisle with the Conestoga Wagon Trophy for the first time since 2003. The Red Devils had a 17-14 lead and Kaschak only had 45-yards at the half, but Troxell kept the ball in his running back's hands. The decision allowed F&M to control the clock for 17:48 of the second half. Dickinson made it 20-14 on its first possession of the third quarter, but Kaschak got the first four touches of the new half to set the tone for the rest of the game. After a 14-yard reception, Kaschak broke off 15 more yards over the next three runs to set up a **John Harrison (Flourtown, Pa. / La Salle College HS) to Jarrell Diggs (Baltimore / Gilman)** 18-yard touchdown. Diggs' score put F&M up 21-20 and gave the Diplomats the lead for good.

Juniata Last Week: A pair of promising first quarter Juniata College drives did not produce any points while Ursinus College was able to score on two of its first four possessions on its way to a 41-0 win over the Eagles. The Eagles fell to 0-3 for the sixth-straight season.

The Coaches: **John Troxell** is in his fifth year as the Diplomats head coach. He is 22-22 in his career. His fourth year ended on an upswing. The Diplomats mentor delivered a 9-2 record and an ECAC bowl win. He was named the Centennial Conference's Coach of the Year and was a national finalist for the highly coveted Liberty Mutual Coach of the Year Award, finishing in second place in fan voting. Troxell and his staff were also selected to coach the South Team offense in the D3 All-Star Classic.

Carmen Felus, a central Pennsylvania native with 14 years coaching experience including a stint at one of Pennsylvania's top Division II programs, begins his second season at the helm of the Juniata football program. He sports a record of 1-12 at Juniata.

Harrison Humming Along: **John Harrison** had quite a night against Dickinson. In his efficient 22-of-26 effort he threw for 215 yards and three touchdowns. In the process, he tied Joe Coviello '77 for career touchdowns at F&M at 52 and became the third passer in Diplomats' history to reach the 5,000-yard plateau.

He enters today's game needing one touchdown pass to take sole ownership of the record for touchdown passes thrown at F&M. His ninth completion will give him sole ownership of passes completed at the college. He needs 310 yards to match Rob Shepardson '83 for second on the passing yards list, and 466 yards to overtake Bill Meekings '94 career passing yards record at F&M. His 65.2 percent career completion percentage is tops at F&M by nearly nine percent, while his pass efficiency rating has jumped up to 142.7, 3.2 points better than any Diplomat starter.

Harrison 6.01: The Diplomats have gained an average of 6.01 yards per play since Harrison became the signal caller in 2008.

Movin' On Up: **Jay Ridinger (Lititz, Pa. / Manheim Twp.)** moved into fifth in career receiving touchdowns in F&M history. His 16th touchdown catch tied him with Larry LoVecchio '77. Ridinger is five touchdowns away from fourth on the list, currently occupied by Bob Kaithern '75, who caught 21 touchdown passes in his career. He is 23 yards away from becoming the ninth Diplomat to amass 1,500 receiving yards in his career and 10 catches away from tying Matt Wagaman '04 for fifth in career receptions at 138.

Kaschak Closing in on Milestone: **John Kaschak** enters today's game with 1,431 rushing yards in his career. A 69-yard effort today would make him the eighth Diplomat to rush for 1,500 yards in his career. A rushing touchdown would mark the 15th of his career, tying him with five other F&M rushers for ninth on the career chart. He turned in the fifth 100-yard game of his career last week and his first two rushing touchdown effort of the season last week.

Savastio the Savior: **Ty Savastio (Downingtown, Pa. / Downingtown East)** saved F&M from the sting of two Dickinson touchdowns. Savastio picked off a Ricky Martz pass in the end zone in the first quarter, then broke up a Martz third down pass that was destined for six points.

Conestoga Grad Helps Grab Conestoga Wagon: **Chris DeStefano (Berwyn, Pa. / Conestoga)** went 5-for-5 on PATs Friday night. This is noteworthy because he was kicking for F&M. His effort marks the first time F&M has been perfect on PATs in a game the Diplomats have scored three or more touchdowns since last year's

21-14 win at Ursinus on October 10. Eight games have passed since that contest, seven of which saw F&M score three or more TDs. DeStefano also piled up five tackles (3 solo) in the win from his spot at safety.

He Tackles Too: You get the sense that senior tight end, **Michael Deutch (Sussex, N.J. / Vernon Twp.)** will do whatever is asked of him. Aside from his four receptions for 44-yards and a touchdown and his week one punting duties, Deutch recorded three open field tackles on kickoffs at Dickinson.

Ball Hogs: Franklin & Marshall held possessed the football for 17:48 of the second half at Dickinson, giving the Diplomats possession for 36:17. It was the most time F&M has held the ball through the three games played this season. Dickinson was only able to muster 92 yards of offense in the second half.

Despite the clock dominance in the second half, it was not the most greedy half of Diplomats' football this season. F&M held the ball for 23:27 of the first half in the win over Washington & Lee. The lopsided time of possession yielded lopsided statistics. F&M rolled up 312 yards of offense compared to Washington & Lee's four and took a 29-0 lead into the break.

Vote of Confidence: F&M is one of three Centennial teams receiving votes in the D3Football.com Top 25. The Diplomats are joined by Johns Hopkins and Ursinus. All three Centennial teams sit outside of the top 25.

Marsh Approaching 10: **C.T. Marsh (Phoenix, Md. / Loyola-Blakefield)** is a half sack away from becoming the 25th Diplomat to record 10 sacks in his career.

Bear Hunter: **C.T. Marsh** has two multiple sack games to his credit. Both were against Ursinus. Marsh led all Diplomat tacklers with 10 stops, eight solo, against Ursinus. That effort included four tackles for losses of 23 yards, half of which were sacks for losses of 16 yards. That performance landed him on the Centennial Conference's Weekly Honor Roll. A year ago at Ursinus, Marsh recorded 1.5 sacks resulting in 11 yards of setbacks for the Bears.

575: Franklin & Marshall's win over Washington & Lee was the program's 575th victory.

Pick Wisely: Two of W&L's drives ended in the F&M end zone with F&M interceptions. **Nick Barbieri (Glen Mills, Pa. / Penncrest)** and **Chris DeStefano** each recorded their first career picks.

A Season of Firsts: In 2009, Harrison became the first F&M and CC QB to reach 250 completions in a season. He also became the first F&M and CC QB to throw 30 touchdowns in a season, as well as the first F&M and CC QB to throw for 3,000 yards in a season.

Preseason Rankings: Franklin & Marshall's football team entered the 2010 season as the 25th ranked team in the nation according to The Sporting News. F&M is also still receiving votes in the D3Football.com Top 25. The Diplomats are coming off of a 9-2 season, that concluded with a come-from-behind, 29-24 win over Wilkes in the ECAC South Atlantic Championship game.

Centennial Poll Position: F&M ranked second in the Centennial Conference preseason football poll and collected seven of the 20 first place votes. Only reigning Centennial Champions Johns Hopkins finished ahead of F&M in the poll with 11 first place nods.

Decorated Coach: John Troxell's fourth year ended on an upswing. The Diplomats mentor delivered a 9-2 record and an ECAC bowl win. He was named the Centennial Conference's Coach of the Year and was a national finalist for the highly coveted Liberty Mutual Coach of the Year Award, finishing in second place in fan voting. Troxell and his staff were also selected to coach the South Team offense in the D3 All-Star Classic.

Captain's Choice: Seniors Jay Ridinger and Mark Surma will lead the 123rd edition of Diplomats football through the 2010 campaign.

Individual Preseason Nods: Tight end, Michael Deutch, and defensive lineman, Mark Surma, were named preseason All-Americans by D3proday.com. Surma was named to the third team, while Deutch earned honorable mention. The team is limited to seniors.

An All-Centennial Second Team pick in 2009, Surma served as the Diplomats' lone junior captain. He will reprise the role in 2010 following a season in which he posted 33 tackles, including four sacks. He forced a fumble as well.

Deutch was an All-Centennial First Team choice in 2010. He wrapped up the season with 35 receptions for 375 yards. He caught nine touchdown passes in 2009 to help the Diplomats to a 9-2 mark and the ECAC South-Atlantic title.

All-Conference Returnees: Four of F&M's eight All-Centennial selections from 2009 return to the gridiron for the 2010 season. Tight end, Michael Deutch, is the only returning first team choice, while quarterback John Harrison, inside linebacker Sam Massaro, and defensive lineman, Mark Surma are returning second team choices.

Deutch made his first All-Centennial appearance following a regular season in which he caught 35 passes for 375 yards and nine touchdowns. His nine, six-point grabs set the Conference's single season record for touchdown catches by a tight end. The record had been owned by a Diplomat, Mike Sernatinger, since 1995. Harrison established dozens of records at Franklin & Marshall and in the Centennial Conference this season. His 276 completions, 3,096 yards, and 32 passing touchdowns are all school and Centennial Conference single season records. He turned in Franklin & Marshall's second-ever 400-yard passing effort with 404 yards and five touchdowns - also a school single game record - at McDaniel. Harrison threw for five touchdowns on two occasions during the 2009 season. A freshman in 2009, Massaro started at middle linebacker from the outset earning Centennial Conference Player of the Week honors after the season-opener. Despite missing the final game of the season to injury, Massaro led F&M in tackles with 22 more than the next closest player. His 70 stops included 43 unassisted efforts, eight for losses, four of which were sacks. Massaro tied for the team lead in interceptions with Lovett, Kellar and Ty Savastio. Each had three on the season. Surma made his first All-Centennial appearance. He recorded 33 tackles, including 17 solo stops this season to go with four sacks and a forced fumble.
